

intentions of our God. Too often, I meet We must not allow the people that think of God as a God who fear of rejection or the seeks to chastise and condemn. While we are certainly called to walk in holiness, we must also understand that grace is extended to us.


Ephesians 2:8-9 tells us, "For by grace you

have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast." We are utterly and totally dependent on grace. There is nothing that we can do in and of ourselves to obtain a right relationship with our Lord.

Because this is true, God's posture toward us is one of grace and compassion. The Bible tells us, "The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance" (2 Peter 3:9). If the idea of a harsh, judgmental God has kept you away, then it is time to change your mindset.

While it is right to be concerned about holiness and honoring God, we must also recognize that God's grace is extended to us. As we will see today, the compassion of Christ is offered to all. We must not allow the fear of rejection or the fear of judgement to stand between us and our Lord. If you have been guilty of this, I pray that you will set that fear aside.


