I understand that this is a unique situation that we have never faced before. However, I feel that the church should lead the way when it comes to social responsibility in these circumstances. I am thankful that we live in a day and age where we have resources such as recording and streaming capabilities. So, on Sunday morning, instead of driving to the church, simply get on the computer and join us for worship.
