WOMEN'S RETREAT

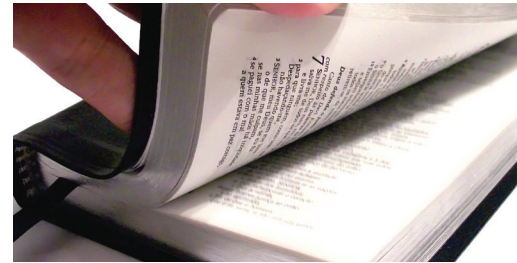

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

One of the few certainties in life is that we will face trials. These trials take on various looks and various forms for each of us, but we will face them. The only choice we really have is whether we will allow these seasons to draw us closer to God or drive us from Him.

Today, we will see the disciples in a literal storm. Jesus has sent them across the Sea of Galilee and they are met with a wind storm. We see in the text that they, “[made] headway painfully.” We are also told that the wind was, “against them.” In addition to the struggle the storm itself presented, this all took place in the dark of night, between 3:00 AM-6:00 AM.

We are told that the disciples were afraid, cried out, and had not thought about the implications of things Jesus had previously done, specifically the feeding of the 5000. We are told that they, “did not understand about the loaves, but their hearts were hardened.”

As we look at this text, there are several things that we need to remember. Just because it is tough does not mean God is not moving. It is through our trials that we grow in our understanding of who He is and, in our ability to trust Him. We must also remember how God has moved in the past. If He has seen me through before, He will do it again. Finally, I must always remember that what is going on is bigger than me. God is moving and working to put His glory on display.

This morning, as we look at this story, I pray that you will be able to lay your trials at the feet of Jesus and trust Him. I pray your trials would not push you away from God but draw you closer.

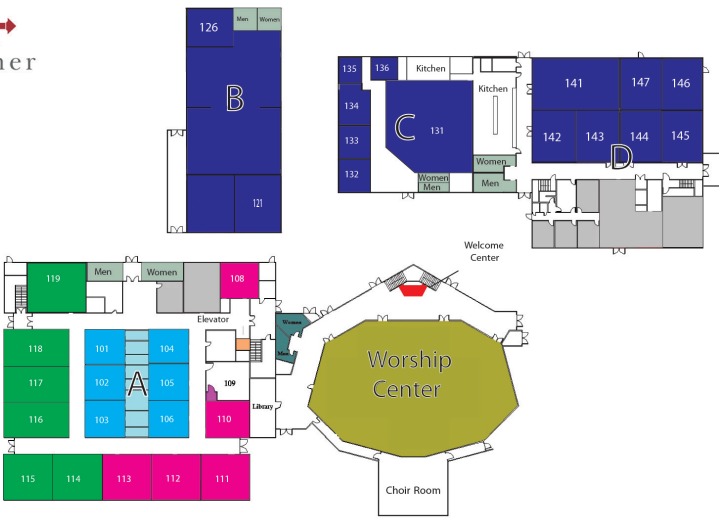
