This summer we go to Glorieta, NM, from June 20 - 24. Register now. A \$60 deposit is due at registration. Camp




#### TEXAS BAPTIST MEN DISASTER RELIEF **TRAINING**

accept as reality and move on. There are other things that we must take a stand against in order to represent the Kingdom.



While I certainly believe Christians should be involved in politics, societal issues, and the law-making process – it is not these things that will produce the greatest good. The greatest amount of energy that I spend ought to be focused on prayer and the gospel. As more and more people come to know and follow Christ, a number of moral issues will resolve. The reality is, we cannot legislate morality. Only a heart changed by Jesus Christ will make a real shift.
