


ONLINE GIVING UPDATE

that to many of us is a familiar story. For One thing is for certain, many, we have grown up in church, or attended vacation bible school, or had a faithful grandmother that has shared this story with us. We, for the most part, at least know the basics of the story.

Here is the caution-familiarity breeds contempt. Sometimes, when we are too familiar with something, we do not give it a lot of thought. In this instance, failing to give these truths thought could have eternal implications. If we are not careful, we can chalk this story up to little more than a story like, "The Boy Who Cried Wolf." However, the weight of this story bears much more weight.


There are really only two options: either the resurrection of Christ is a fact, or it is not. If it is not, we can dismiss it and move on. However, if it is true, it changes everything. If it is true, then Christ is who He said He was and we must surrender. If it is true, then we must acknowledge that Christ has called us to take up our cross and follow Him (Matthew 16:24-26).

One thing is for certain, we cannot remain neutral as it relates to the resurrection. We must decide for ourselves whether or not we believe it. If we do, then things in our life must change. We cannot proceed as if it is business as usual. Christ calls us to a life of surrender, a life of sacrifice, and a life of purpose. To ignore these things and proceed as normal will absolutely be detrimental to our future.
