THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

With this being Easter Sunday, I realize that there are people here who may not have been in church for a while. The reasons you have come may vary. Maybe you came because it is a special Sunday. Maybe you came because a mom or a grandmother asked you to come. Maybe you came because your kids asked you to be here today. Whatever the case, I want you to know you are not here by accident. However God got you here, you are here for his purposes.

This Easter we will look at the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ and what that means to us. In the meantime, I would like you to consider the word CROSS as a bit of an acronym that points us to salvation, each letter revealing an important truth.

Confess. In order to experience salvation, we must first be willing to confess that we are a sinner. This is no shocking revelation. Romans 3:23 tells us, "all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."

Recognize Christ's sacrifice. It would be one thing for God to tell us we were sinners and then abandon us, but He did not do that. Our God sent Jesus Christ to die for our sin. Romans 5:8 states, "God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."

Open your heart to Christ. To understand Jesus' sacrifice and to embrace it are two separate things. Each of us must personalize the acceptance of such a sacrifice. Romans 10:9-10 says, "If you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."

Seek the Lord's saving grace. The beauty of coming to our Lord is this, he is not a God that shows favoritism. Romans 10:13 tells us, "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." Regardless of where you have been or what you have done, if you call on Christ, he will save you.


Surrender your will to His plan. When we come to Christ, we must realize that our agenda no longer reigns. It is God's will and plan for our life that takes priority. Second Corinthians 5:15 says, "he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for him who for their sake died and was raised."

So, whether you are in church for the first time, or the first time in a long time, I hope today will be a day that you recognize what God has done for you. Maybe you have been in church regularly, but have sort of been doing your own thing, I pray that today will be the day you fully surrender to the Lord.
