This summer we go to Glorieta, NM, from June 20 - 24. Register now. A \$60 deposit is due at registration. Camp is \$379.




SENIOR SUNDAY

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Throughout history, humanity has wanted God to do things the way we want and when we want. When God does not show up as we wish, we become angry, frustrated, and discouraged. It is as if we forget that God has a larger plan, more wisdom than we can fathom, and is working all things to our good. Instead of trusting and resting in Him, we become anxious and fearful.

In our text today, we will see that we are not that different than the folks in Jesus' time. In their minds, they knew exactly what kind of a Messiah they needed. They needed someone who was going to come in, overthrow the Roman government, and establish a


new government in which Israel was the head and not the tail. The problem, and the solution, could not have been more clear, so they thought.

When Jesus arrives, He is riding on a donkey, something that should have clued them in, but they missed it. As he rides into town, the people shout and wave palm branches. The palm branches had become a nationalistic symbol, much like our flag would represent today. As they waived these flags and declared Jesus, "the King of Israel," they had certain things in mind. Unfortunately, what they had in mind could not have been further from the will of God.


Sunday's excitement turned into Friday's indignation. The same people who shouted and cheered on Sunday were now calling for the crucifixion of Jesus on Friday. Why? Because God did not do what they wanted, when they wanted, and how they wanted. Clearly, if Jesus was the true Messiah, He would have known what was best.

We can look at all of this and shake our heads at their shortsightedness. However, we must ask, are we that different than they were? Do we display greater faith? Do we show greater trust? I would hope so, but I must admit, I am sometimes guilty of the same shortsightedness that those first century individuals were guilty of. So, I pray that in this Easter season we will once again be reminded to trust and relax.
