

One of the most challenging things Hosea has thrown at us is the constant intertwining of grace and judgement. We have repeatedly seen God issue judgements

and decrees against Israel that only seem to increase in fervor. However, just when it seems the flame can grow no hotter, in comes a promise of grace. The truth is, it is almost disorienting.

In our own lives, it does not seem to get much easier. When we choose to sin, we

too have to balance the possibility of discipline with the promise of grace. How is it that we make sense of these two? Which is it, should I expect discipline or grace?

I think the secret to finding balance is to realize that even in discipline, God is displaying grace. Hebrews 12:11 tells us, "For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it." I think God, much like our parents, just said, "This hurts me more than it does you, but I have to do it because I love you."


