

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

I have often said that part of the beauty of the gospel lies in the fact that it is so simple a child can lay hold of it, yet so complex that the greatest theologian will never plumb

its depths. On the one hand, it is a simple reality that is laid out for us in passages like 1 Corinthians 15:3-4, "For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures..." Christ died for our sins, He was buried,

and He rose again.

On the other hand, the outworking of the gospel in our lives will take an eternity to understand. How is it that the gospel works in my weakness? How is it that God takes a broken, shameful sinner like myself and uses him to bring glory to Himself? How is it that the gospel is working in some mysterious way through my relationships and connections to bring about redemption? Our finite minds will never be able to lay hold of this infinite beauty. And all of this without even discussing how the gospel is working toward the redemption of all creation.


Despite the complexity of the gospel, this morning's call is simple. In this final chapter, Hosea calls us to lay aside everything that stands in the way and turn to our Lord. For us, on this side of the cross, we can say that we must make a decisive decision to follow Christ and lay aside all else. A call that seems so simple, yet we struggle to obey.

Today, if you find yourself trusting in any number of things instead of the Lord, lay those things down. Hear the call of Hosea to "return." Return conveys the same idea as repent. To repent is to turn away from what is ungodly and to turn toward the Lord Himself. It is a simple decision but must be a decisive decision. If you hear the call of God today, do not turn away.
