
BLESSING BAGS



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

If you could ask Jesus one question, face to face, what would it be? In today's passage, we are going to see a man who had this opportunity. He is only identified as one of the scribes. We are told that he has heard Jesus answering other questions and, "seeing that he answered them well," he asked, "Which commandment is most important of all?"



This was a common question that the scribes, Pharisees, and teachers of the law liked to debate. However, this man decided he would take his question to a higher authority.

As Jesus and this scribe's conversation progresses, we learn some interesting

things. First of all, we see that the most important thing we can do is love the Lord with everything we are. Second, we discover that loving our neighbor is almost as important as loving God. If we are not careful, we will stop reading and maybe miss the biggest point of all.

As this man affirms Jesus' answer, Jesus says to him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." That should catch our attention. This man clearly has a solid understanding of what the word of God says. He has committed his life to the study and practice of this word. Why is Jesus telling him he is not far from the kingdom? And, if he is not there yet, am I at risk?

Careful consideration of this text reveals the fact that this man, the scribe, has an intellectual understanding of God, but he lacks any sort of personal relationship with God. You see, just knowing about God is not enough. In fact, even believing in God is not enough. We must come to the point that we are whole heartedly committed to God's purposes for our life. There must be a relationship that exists, not just mere understanding.

If you have not come to this place yet, my prayer for you is that today would be the day.
