
We have a separate VBS for 5th grade. It is the same date and time, just a little different. Register for Merge on our website.

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Have you ever known someone who can take the profoundly simply and turn it into the astonishingly difficult? They take a simple task or process, and they over think it and over analyze it. Before long, what was so simple moments before has become confused and confounded. If you have experienced this, you know how frustrating it is.

As we will see in our text this morning, if we are not careful, we can do the exact same thing with our walk with the Lord. God has made it painfully simple to walk in relationship with Him. Simple, but not simplistic. To walk in relationship with God, we simply need to follow His son. We see it over and over again in scripture as Christ simply says, "Follow me"

This call to, "Follow me," is a call to faith and trust. It is a call to abandon all our own means and to trust Him. For some reason, we want to make it more complex than it is. We try to add our own rules. We try to add steps that we have to take. We try to make it something that it is not. But, the fact remains, we are simply called to follow Him by faith.

When we get things confused and try to make it more, or less, than it is, we miss out on the life of blessing that God has purposed for us. We forget to trust in him and begin to trust in our own means. We start trying to solve problems that we were never intended to solve. We start looking for solutions and methods that are not up to us. All the while, God is calling us to just step back and trust Him.

Today's passage ends with a rather piercing question. Jesus asks to the disciples, "Do you not yet understand?" Ouch! They had been with Him, heard Him, and followed Him. Yet, there was something they still were not getting. They were worried about too many things. They were trying to solve too many things. Jesus is saying to them, just step back and trust me. I believe He would say the same thing to you and me.
