#### PARENT/CAMPER MEETING



My parents had come to town for the concert, and I mentioned it to my dad.

He looked at me for a second and then said, "I bet I know what is going on." He asked where the power came into the church, so I showed him. Sure enough, one of the wires from the main drop had burned in two. Thus, half power.


I had a church full of people, a family band ready to perform, and not enough electrical power to run the building. Of course, the power company could not get to us for hours. So, what was I to do? We scrambled around with great urgency, trying to figure something out. I told Mrs. Bailey what was going on and apologized. She asked if there was anyway I could get power enough to run their microphones. We actually had a separate drop on a pole outside, so I could. In an act that displayed a tremendous servant heart, the show went on, in the dark, but with amplified voices.

From time to time in our lives, we find ourselves in a situation in which we act with great urgency. This is the call of Christ this morning, live your life with urgency. To act with haste for a moment is easy. But, to act with haste for a lifetime takes focus. My prayer for us is that we can live with such commitment, focus, and urgency.
