If someone were to ask you to define worship, what would you say? If they asked, what is worship to you, how would your respond? Romans 12:1 tells us, “*I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.*”

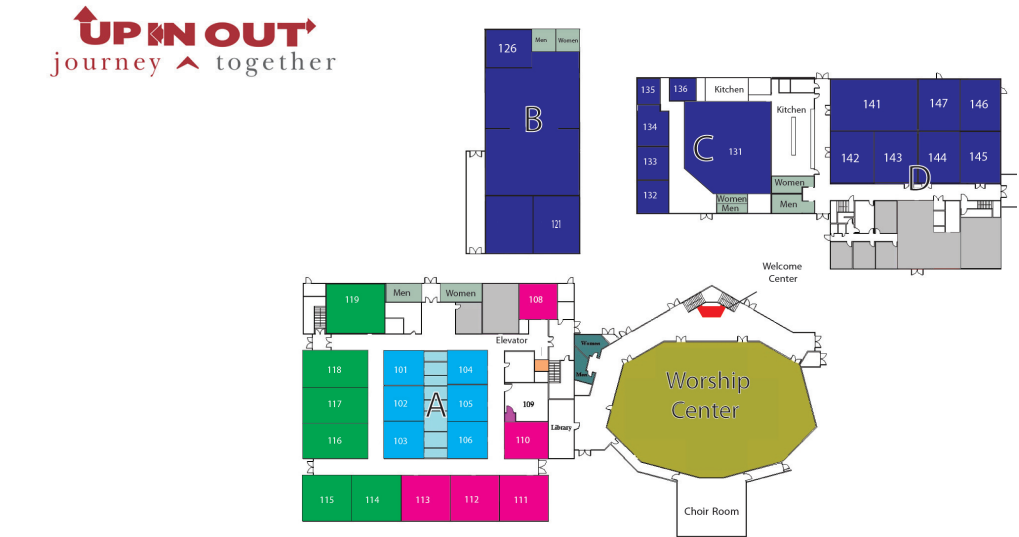
