#### UPWARD FLAG FOOTBALL/CHEERLEADING



### THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

It seems that each Memorial Day I am asked why we did not honor veterans. The answer to that question is simple. Memorial Day serves a specific purpose, to honor those who have died while serving in the U.S. Military. Early in my ministry career, I did not draw much distinction between Memorial Day and Veterans Day. Then, we experienced the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. For the first time, my generation experienced what it was to lose people in war.

While serving as pastor in Canyon Lake, these distinctions became all too real. Canyon Lake is near San Antonio, which means a number of retired military personnel live at the lake. In our congregation were a number of high-ranking military officers. I will never forget the look in one Lieutenant Colonel's eyes when he said to me, "Do not honor veterans on Memorial Day. It is not for us. It is for the men and women that I commanded in Iraq that did not return home." Suffice it to say, I have been forever changed by his heart and passion for his fallen comrades.

So, today we pause. We pause to reflect on the high price that has been paid for the lifestyle we enjoy. We pause to remember. We remember those who have given their lives to preserve the freedoms we know. And we pause to say thank you. Thank you to those who felt that no price was too high a price to pay for liberty.


Today, we live in a society that is deeply divided on many issues. I am afraid that this division, and the deep-rooted feelings around it, are going to be the death of America as we know it. How sad, that men and women have fought and died to preserve this great nation, and now she is at risk. Not at risk of a foreign enemy, but at risk from within. I pray that we might remember the heart and attitude of those who have died on our behalf. I pray we might embody the same attitude. I am sure that on the battle front, that people with differing views stand side by side and fight. Why? Because what unites them is greater than what divides them.

We live in a great nation. We have freedoms that were purchased for us with the blood of soldiers. We must also recognize that such freedom is the result of the sovereign will and grace of our God. With this in mind, may we strive for a better America. Pray for revival. Stand for truth. Work for unity. And, always shine the light of Christ in the world in which we live.
