

called to preach the word of God, you better get well acquainted with it. My mother purchased a rather expensive study Bible for me. This particular Bible was called, The Open Bible. Of course, the text was the same, but the study resources were incredible, especially for a pre-internet world.

As I began to use this Study Bible, I fell more and more in love with the word of God. On top of that is in you.'

fruit. Additionally, the sense of call that I had only grew stronger. Something began to burn inside me as I made a habit of reading and studying the Bible. It was something that was truly inexplicable, especially for a sixteen-year-old young man.

It was only later in my life that I discovered that there were people who dismissed the Bible. For them, it seemed irrelevant. For one reason or another, they had found a way to justify their dismissal of the very word of God. For some, it was the life they saw believers live. For others, they had come to believe that the word of God was filled with inconsistencies. For still others, they could not grasp how the very word of God would come to be in our hands.


So how do we answer such people? When the word of God means so very much to us, how do we engage with those who dismiss it? How do we answer their questions? Well, to a certain extent, we must leave it to the Holy Spirit to convince them. However, we must also heed the call of 1 Peter 3:15, "...always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you."

Hopefully today's sermon will begin the process of thinking that will help you develop a sound answer as to why you believe the Bible is true. Once we establish the truth of Scripture, there are a number of implications that will begin to unfold from there.
