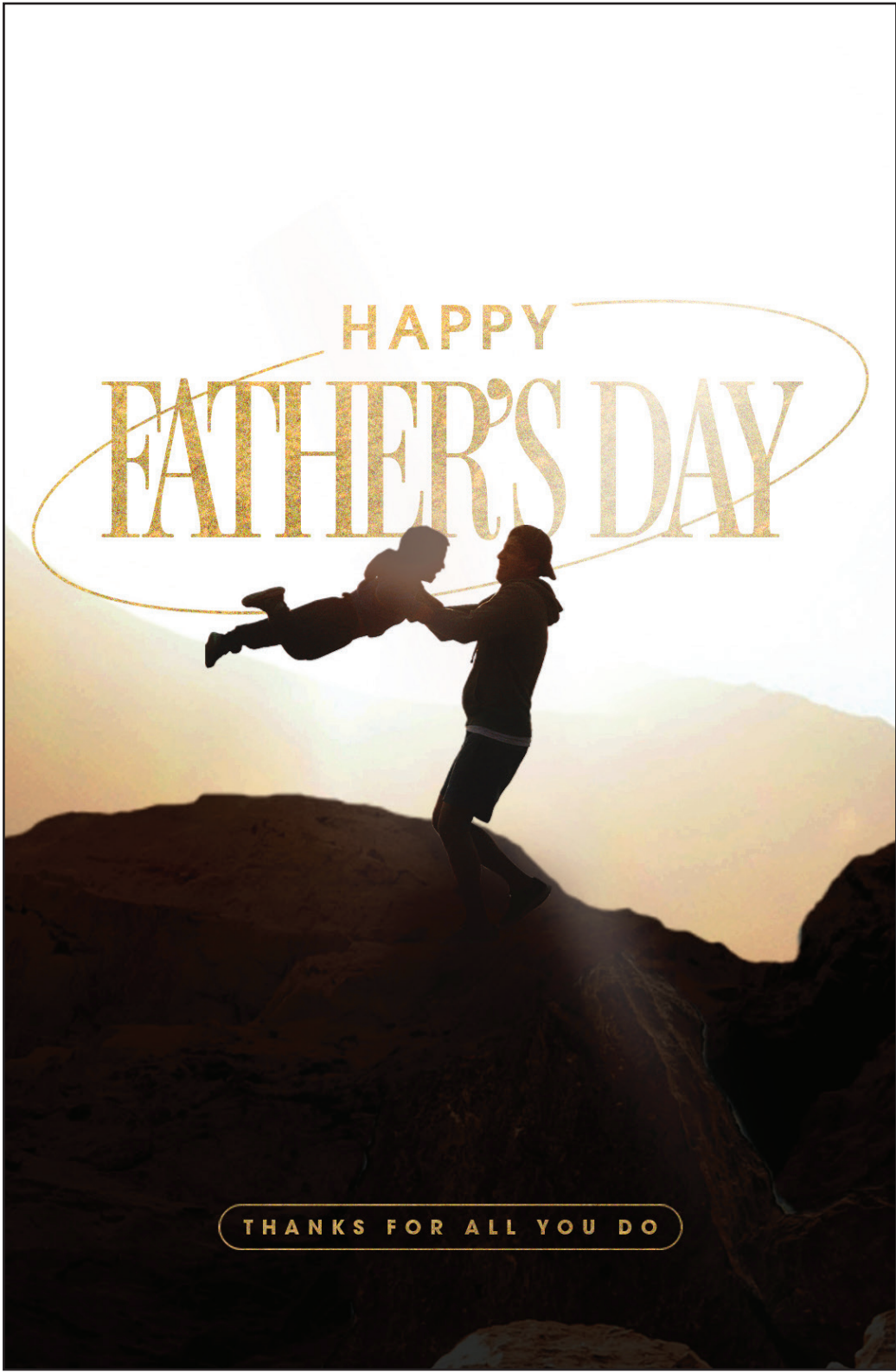

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

As our society “progresses,” there is a great pressure for us to moderate or even change our beliefs as Christians. This pressure is nothing new. If we look at the pages of

scripture, we will see that such pressure has always existed. In fact, it is not a surprise that we are out of step with culture, it is the expectation.

As we consider these things, there are several things that we must do to protect ourselves.

First of all, stay in the word of God. You may think that you know what the Bible says and do not need to review it on a daily basis. However, the deep weight and power of the word can fade if we do not interact with it regularly. Before long, we begin to think it is no big deal if we soften on this idea or that, and soon we are adrift. Read your Bible.

Second, we need to keep solid Christian friends around us. I have never been a proponent of hiding from the world, but our primary relationships should be with those who walk in the same convictions we do. If my only friends are on the opposite side of the spectrum than I am, it will not be long before I start compromising my beliefs. Seek accountability.

Third, develop your sense of conviction. Know what you believe and why you believe it. Do not base your beliefs on what your grandparents, parents, or even the denomination you belong to. Spend time in the word, in prayer, and in contemplation. Out of these things, your convictions will grow. Walk in that conviction.

Remember, it is those things about us that are different that become our witness. If everything we believe and everything we do is the same as the world, why do they need to come to Christ? Walk in love, stand on your convictions, pray for those around you, but never give in and go against the world of God.
