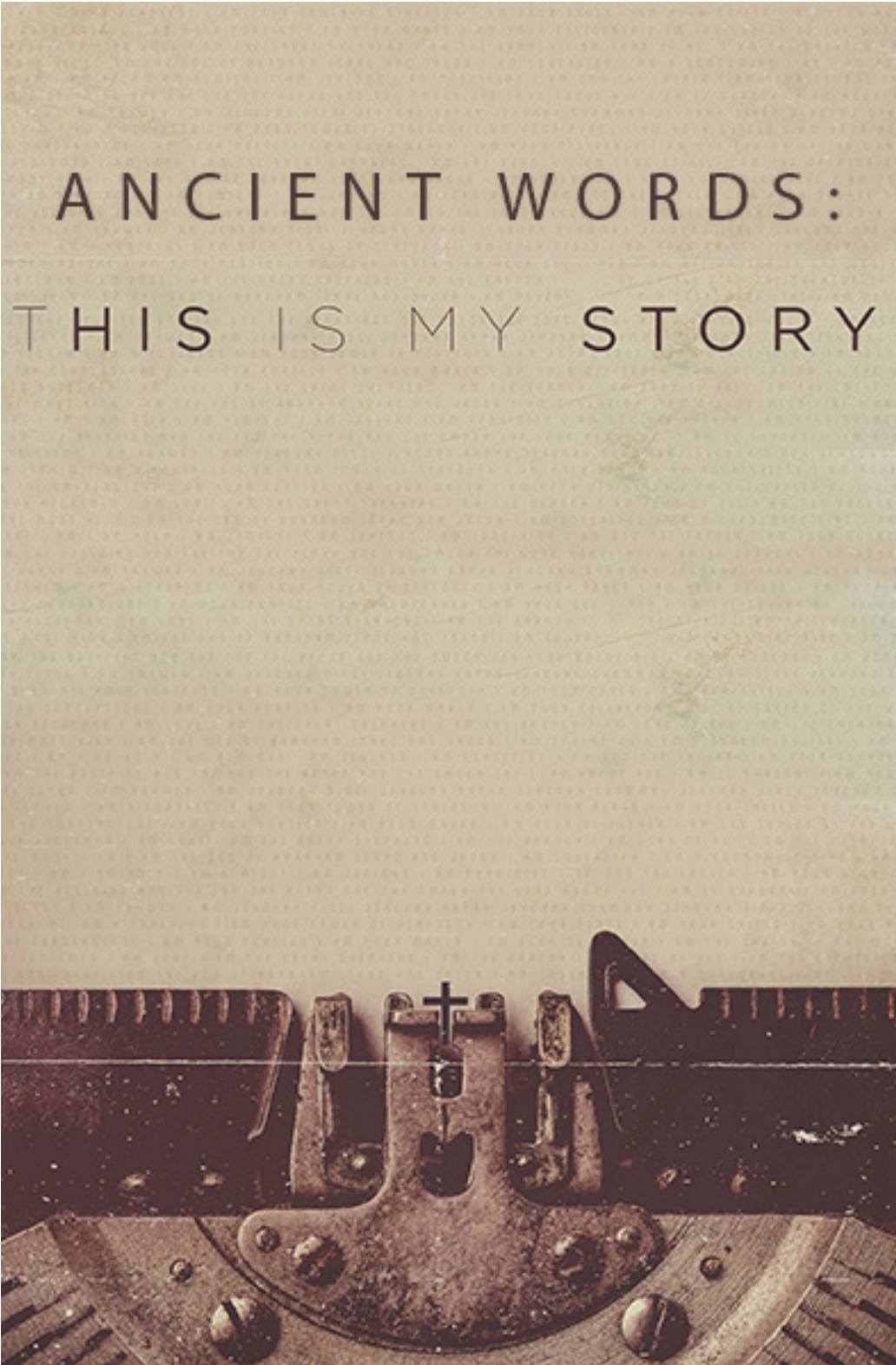
**UPWARD FLAG FOOTBALL/CHEERLEADING**

Habakkuk 3:19

A teenager in rebellion, a Sunday School teacher, and a different translation - the Amplified Bible. That’s how Habakkuk 3:19 became “My Verse”.

My dad was always changing jobs, and we moved all over - even Hawaii. Two kindergartens, 3 high schools, and lots of others in between left me without a foundation of friends or relatives. Sometimes we went to church, sometimes not depending on where we lived and how my dad felt. After 9th and 10th grade in Hawaii and 11th in Oregon I was burnt-out on school for 12th grade in Norman, Oklahoma.

A Sunday School teacher at First Baptist Church became my mentor with horses and Jesus. She used the Amplified Bible and only the Amplified Bible helped me understand the importance of walking onward.

Knowing God is MY strength, MY personal bravery, and MY invincible army. He will make me to walk, not to stand still in terror, and make spiritual progress upon my high places of trouble, suffering, or responsibility. Now at age 68, I’ve learned that these problems can come one at a time or all 3 together. My confidence and trust rest in my heavenly Father, my Lord and Savior, Jesus, and my Comforter, the Holy Spirit. I frequently don’t understand the “why” of life’s trials. I have learned to keep walking, knowing who I believe in. I hope others will see this Old Testament book in a new light and spend some time walking with Habakkuk.

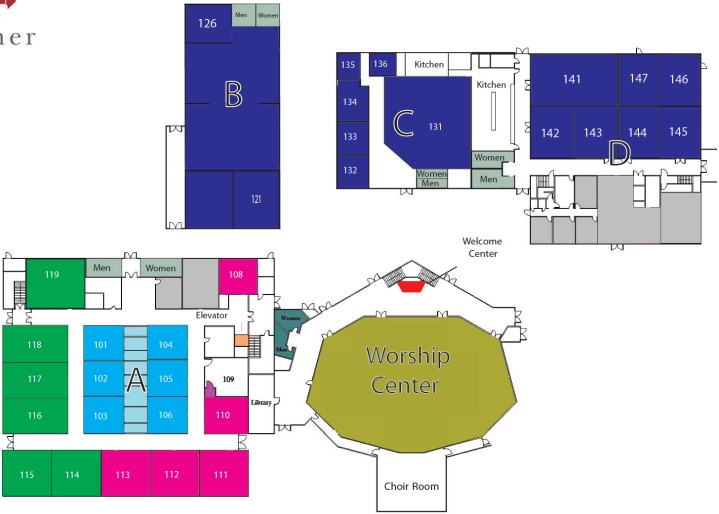
**Ancient Words: This Is My Story**
