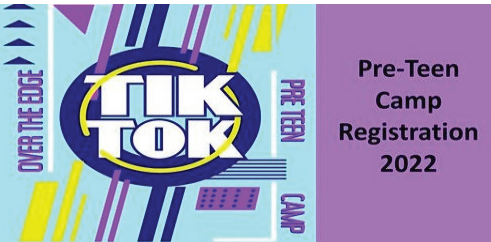


WOMEN'S NIGHT IS BACK

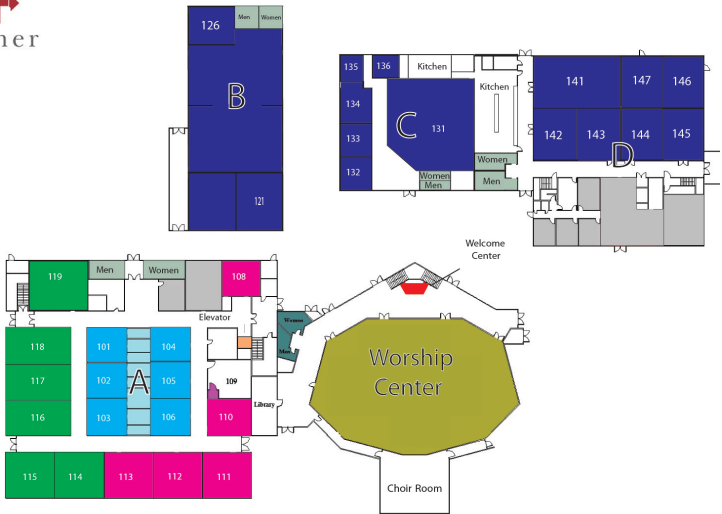
