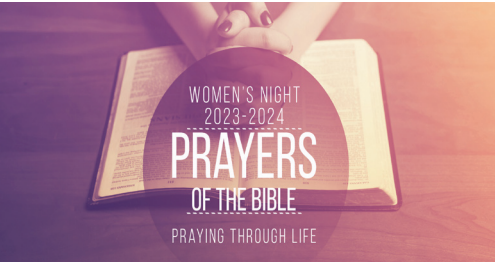


INCOMING 6TH GRADE HANGOUT

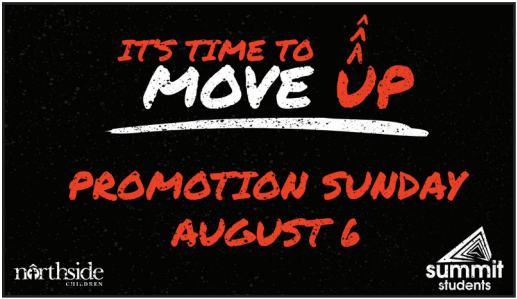
UPWARD MINISTRY MEETING

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

We live in a peculiar day and age. Not only are we subjected to a constant flow of news and opinions, we also have multiple opportunities to express our own ideas. When there is such a free flow of ideas, conflict is sure to be right behind. Conflict, in and of itself, is not necessarily a bad thing. However, when Christians do not reflect our Savior in the way we handle such conflict, it does incalculable damage to our witness.

In recent months, I have been giving some thought as to why it is we often respond as we do. Why is it that we can be volatile? Why is it that we allow ourselves to get so worked up? Why do we say things, or act in ways that our Lord would never approve of? I have come to this conclusion, too often we are driven by fear.

We are afraid of what is happening in our culture. We are afraid of what is happening to our country. We are afraid of what is happening to our churches. We are afraid of what the government is up to. As a result, we let this fear drive us. Once we have given over to the fear, we are no longer truly in control.

This morning I want to remind you that we serve a God that is sovereign over all. There is not a single hair that blows in the wind without His knowing. There is not a leaf that falls from a tree that it is not part of His plan. The problem for us is, we can only see the immediate. We cannot see where this is going. We cannot fully know what God is up to. So let me encourage you, while it is impossible to take comfort in the direction of things, it is possible to take comfort in the One who governs all things.

Isaiah 41:10 tells us, “Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.” Not a bad word of comfort.

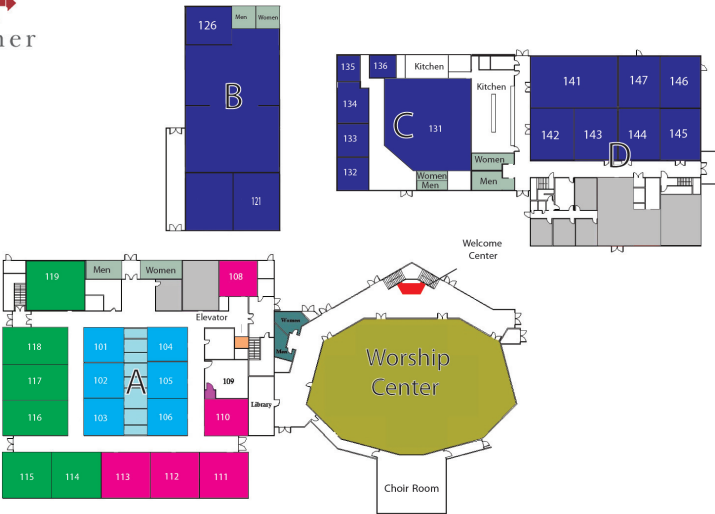
