THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

One simple look at scripture and you will see that the gospel tears down walls. In the New Testament culture, both women and children were viewed as little more than possessions. They had few rights, if any, and were not exactly treated well. However,

when Christ began to change lives, other things changed as well. One of the things we take note of is that Jesus placed value on both women and children.

As you would hope to see, Jesus’ followers embraced His ideology towards these things. As the gospel writers began to tell their stories, they made sure that both women and children were given

their proper due. In our text today, we will see this very thing. It was women, not men, who discovered the empty tomb. It was women, not men, who sought to care for the body of Jesus.

Understandably, you might be tempted to say, what is the big deal. But, when you consider that the testimony of women would not typically be accepted, and you see that Mark put them front and center of his gospel account, you begin to see the risk that he took. There were those who would have rejected these writings, because in part, they were based on the testimony of women. Mark, however, knew that God had a bigger plan. Mark simply told the story as it was.

As you consider these things, realize that the gospel does not simply change the way we see others in our society. It changes everything. The gospel changes my standing before God. The gospel changes what life is about. The gospel changes my focus. But more than any of that, the gospel changes the purpose and direction of my life.

I hope that if you are here today, and you have not done so previously, that you will come to a place that you personally embrace the gospel. Allow the gospel to have its work in your life. Allow the gospel to make all things new.

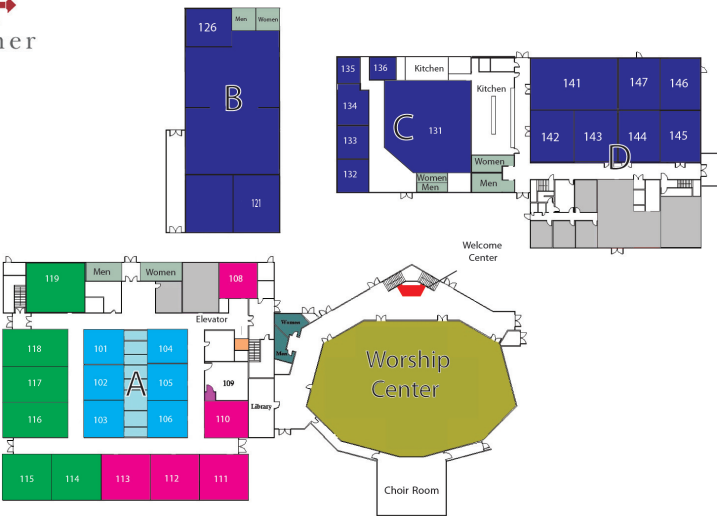
