
WEDNESDAY NIGHT MEAL

PRAIZ KIDZ STARTS BACK



The question we have before us today, as part of our series, "Asking For A Friend," is, Why am I still here? In other words, if I have trusted Christ and my

eternity is secure, why has He not taken me out of this broken, sinful world? The short answer is, He still has work for us to do. However, let's go deeper.

We will see in 2 Peter 3 that God is patient and desires to see all come to repentance.

He has not forgotten His promise or changed the plan, He patiently waits for all who will come to Him. When the time comes, the Covenant of grace will close, and judgement will ensue. At that time, those who have trusted Him will receive their reward and those who have not will be condemned to eternal judgement.


So, what do we do in the meantime? We must be about the Lord's business. We must make sure that we are walking with Him. We must make sure that we are walking in holiness. We must make sure that we live according to His call. In the end, Christ will return, according to God's perfect plan. But for now, we have work to do.

There is an interesting phrase in our passage today. It says that we are to, "hasten the coming of the day of God" (2 Peter 3:12). Clearly, God works according to His sovereign will. However, it seems that this verse puts a responsibility on us to finish the work at hand so that the path is clear for our Lord's return. While we cannot fully understand how God's sovereignty and our obedience work together, we know what He has called us to and must be about His business.
