# THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Nothing is more clear than how you plan, raise, and manage your family, until you have a family. I remember as a young, married adult, I used to watch people with their children and think, I will never let my kids do that. I would go so far as to think, I could fix that for you. It seemed so simple, so clear. Set your expectations, be clear, be consistent, and all will work out.

The same is true with money. I used to look at people and think, what’s wrong with you? Why can’t you manage your money any better than that? How is it that you were not prepared for that emergency? All of these things fall in the category of Family Matters. We know that family does matter, but so often it is difficult to manage everything, or anything, well. We try, but the situation just simply takes over. Well, over the next few weeks, we will take a look at what the Bible has to say about some of these areas. We will not try to find complex solutions to our problems, but look to the simple, well-aged advice that scripture gives us. Maybe the solution is not more complexity, but a little simplicity.

I will not even begin to pretend that I have it all figured out or get it right every time. However, I will seek to tell you what scripture says and maybe even offer a dose or two of advice. Please remember, this is a journey, and we all journey together. We will have to help each other along, show each other grace, and even hold each other accountable. But fear not, we can get there.
