resources. I have noticed that often, when people focus on wrong things, they end up in places they do not want to be – emotionally, immediate, what is right spiritually, and even financially. A wrong in front of us, it is going focus will lead to the wrong destination.

> Our backyard is a fairly good size, especially for the neighborhood we are in. From one


side of our yard to the other is a fair stretch. When I was teaching my boys to mow, I told them that in order to mow a straight line, they needed to pick a point on the fence and walk straight to it. I told them not to look down immediately in front of them on the first pass, but to focus on a particular destination. If they were to just look immediately in front of them, it would be nearly impossible to mow a straight line (yes, I am that uptight about my yard, just ask them).

What is true of mowing is true of life. If we spend all our time focused on the immediate, what is right in front of us, it is going to be difficult to arrive at our destination. We, like that lawn mower, will cut a crooked line. But, if we can focus on the destination, we have a far greater chance of cutting a straight line.


When it comes to our walk with Christ, the destination (or mission) has been pointed out for us. Jesus has called us to go and make disciples of all people. This Great Commission appears in all four gospels and the book of Acts. If we want to be all that Christ has called us to be, as individuals and as a church, we must be focused on the goal. When we fail to focus on the goal, we will drift. Soon, things that should not matter begin to matter. Things that should not bother us begin to bother us. Things that do not deserve our attention begin to take all of our attention.

So, in the days ahead, make an effort to focus on right things. Do not allow Satan to play his game of distract and discourage. Continue to press toward the high call of God in all you do.
