

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

There are many patterns and practices that we can trace through the New Testament and even the Bible as a whole. One such pattern is the pattern of

conception through the end of the book, prayer stands as a central discipline practiced by the church.

prayer. One would struggle to read any significant amount of scripture without reading of prayer. We often see the people of God turning to God in desperation.

Where it really becomes interesting is in the New Testament. It is there that we discover the absolute dependence of

the early church on prayer. In fact, the church itself was born out of a prayer meeting. From that initial conception through the end of the book, prayer stands as a central discipline practiced by the church.

Whether it was a prayer to make it through a difficult time, a prayer for wisdom, or a prayer to proclaim the gospel boldly, prayer was a definite part of the DNA of the early church. It seems at times, when you read the New Testament, that prayer was almost a reflex response from those early Christians.


So, the question becomes, if prayer was such a vital part of the early church's operation, what has happened to us? Why is it that we are not praying more? Why is it that prayer is not our first response, but viewed as a last resort? What would happen if we could make this shift? What if we made the sort of habit out of prayer that the early church did?

Today, as we look at prayer, I hope that we will be stirred and convicted. I know in my own life, I approach prayer way too passively. I need to be more passionate and intentional about this discipline. I hope that you will take an honest look at your life as well. Where does prayer rank in the priorities of your life?
