

> Today, we will start a study of 1 Peter. One of the things that we will discover is that


Peter begins his letter by discussing our identity in Christ. This letter is written to Christians, scattered around the world, to encourage them in the midst of their suffering. Interestingly enough, Peter does not start out with some sort of, "things will get better," type of encouragement. Instead, he deep dives their relationship with Christ and all that it means.

I hope that as we study, you will consider how these things translate to you. The things that Peter says are not simply for the people of his day, but for us as well. The truths that are laid forth apply to us and will help us in our own difficult hour.


