



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

The first of seven realities that Henry Blackaby shares in his study *Experiencing God*, is that God is always at work around you. Give that a moment to soak in, God is always at work. That means that whether you are at a baseball game, at work, playing dominos with friends, or shopping for groceries, God is at work. Thus, we merely need to pay attention, see where He is moving, and join Him there.

Today, we celebrate our first ever *Frontline Sunday*. Of course, this is also Labor Day Weekend. We did not choose this weekend by accident. For those who are in the workforce, you will spend a large part of each day with coworkers and customers. We believe that where you are is more than an accident. We believe that God put you there. So, this makes the perfect weekend to think about how to minister to your frontline.

We are also aware that many are not in the traditional workforce. Whether you are at home with kiddos, retired, or simply not working at the moment, you too have a frontline. That frontline might be where you live, where you play, who you homeschool with, or simply in the flow of daily life.
