

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

As we continue our study of 1 Peter, let us remember that he is giving us instruction as to how we ought to live godly in an ungodly world. It is a difficult thing to maintain

holiness. We are called to walk in a way that reflects the heart and character of God. **)**

our distinctives when all the world around We are called to walk in us would push back. However, it is of the utmost importance that we do so. It is our distinctives that cause us to stand apart. It is our distinctives that will become appealing as people discover that the values of this world are empty.


In our text today, there are three questions that will emerge. The first question is the most pivotal, "What will you do with Jesus?" Either you will make Him the Lord of your life, or you will dismiss Him as of no consequence. There really is no middle ground. Either He is everything or He is nothing. It is my prayer that you will realize that He is everything.

Second, if we determine that Christ is all, then we must ask, "What will we do with the ways of the flesh?" Clearly, God calls us to walk away from those things. We are called to walk in holiness. We are called to walk in a way that reflects the heart and character of God. While we do not hear a lot of talk these days about holiness, repentance, and righteousness, they are still important to our God.


Third, once we have dealt with the Christ question and the holiness question, we must deal with the question of calling. You see, it is not only pastors who are called, it is every single person that surrenders their life to Christ. True, we may not be called to vocational ministry, but we are called to a new direction and a new purpose. Simply put, we form a new sort of priesthood whereby we are to be about the business of our God.

My prayer for you, and for myself, as we walk through 1 Peter, is that we will have a renewed sense of calling to righteousness and service. I pray that God would use this series to rekindle the flame that burns for Him. It is my hope that we come away from this series changed. May God do a work in your life and mine.
