#### UPWARD FLAG FOOTBALL





# THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Today we begin a new series entitled, "This Is the Church." During the course of this series, we will be sharing with you four things that we believe are necessary for us to fulfill our calling as a church. Today, we will be looking at the first of these four things, the importance of corporate worship. We believe that scripture gives a clear mandate that we are to meet, just as we are today, as a corporate body. This is a time that we come together as a body and worship together as well as look at the word of God together.


Next week, we will look at the importance of small group gatherings. Just as corporate worship is important, it is also important to gather in small groups where you can share, ask questions, and pray together. It is our hope that every member of Northside would be involved in a group. Whether that group is a traditional Sunday Morning Bible study, a Sunday Night Bible Study, or a group that meets at another time, we believe there is value in the small group setting.

In week three we will take up a topic that we might not be as familiar with. We will be talking about the importance of a small accountability group. By small, we mean 3-4 people. This is not another Bible study, though you may take some time to share scripture. This is a time for one believer to look at another believer and ask, how are you doing? How is your personal Bible study? How is your worship of the Lord? How is your family? Are you faithfully witnessing for our Lord? The hope is that you can be honest, encourage one another, and pray for one another. We will be rolling out the accountability groups in January. We will call them, "Triads," but do not wait on us. If you have two or three people you are close to, get going.


Finally, in week four, we will encourage you to be missionally engaged. Or as our purpose statement puts it, to intentionally engage your community. We want to encourage each member to find an area of service and serve. Find a place that you are not on the receiving end, but on the giving end. Only as we serve can we effectively grow.

Consider these four areas. Where are you strong? Where do you need work? Is there something that you can do right now to improve the picture? If so, get to it. We know that we always have room for growth.
