

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

Authority is a word that can have either a positive or negative connotation. Negatively, we can all think of those who have abused their power. Instead of using the authority that they hold for the purposes of good, they use their power for self-serving reasons. We have all heard these stories in the news along with the stories of devastation that follow.

On the other hand, authority is something that can be used to change lives for the good. One who possesses authority has the opportunity to make a difference that matters. Instead of using it for one’s own purposes, it is used for the good of others. Lives can be changed, futures can be altered, and hope can be restored. This is the very kind of authority that our Lord chose to use.

In Mark 1, we see Jesus launch His ministry. In rather quick succession, we see Jesus call His first four disciples, amaze the masses with His teachings, cast out demons, and heal the sick. Truly, He used the authority given to Him by His Heavenly Father to change lives for the good.

As we look at these stories, it is important for us to ask, what difference have we allowed Jesus to make in our own lives? The same authority that He used in the preceding situations; He still possesses. Just as He used it in the lives of people in scripture, He desires to use it in our lives. You will note that the people in these stories had to submit themselves to the call or action of our Lord. In the same way, we must submit ourselves.

I will close by asking you this, in what area of your life have you been resisting the authority of our Lord? What area of your life do you still need to submit to Him? The word “immediately” continues to appear in our text. It is an important word. It is the speed at which your life can change if you will submit to Him – immediately.
