WOMEN'S NIGHT



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

How would you define genuine worship? Too often, when we think about worship, we only think in terms of style or familiarity but, worship is so much more. One of the

passages of scripture that always comes to mind when I think about worship is John 4. In this chapter, we see Jesus engage with a woman near a well.

At first, the conversation seems normal enough. Jesus asks her for a drink of water. She is a little taken aback at first, because Jesus is both a male and a Jew. Men did not

talk to women and Jews did not talk to Samaritans. Nonetheless, she and Jesus end up in a conversation. She begins by asking how it is that he, a Jewish man, would ask her, a Samaritan woman, for a drink (v. 9). Jesus then tells her that if she knew who he was, she would have asked him and he would have given her living water (v. 10).

This simple exchange sets the conversation on a different course. She then asks Jesus a question about worship. Ultimately, Jesus tells her that a time is coming when true worshippers will worship in spirit and truth (v. 23).


Prior to the completion of this conversation on worship, there is a somewhat strange exchange that takes place between this woman and Jesus. In verse 16, Jesus tells her to go and call her husband. She tells Jesus she has no husband, and he says, you are right, you have had five and the man you are currently living with is not your husband. I have often wondered why Jesus brought this up in the middle of a conversation on worship. I have come to this conclusion:

Jesus needed to expose the deepest place of her hurt so that he could show her the riches of his grace. Only then could she begin to understand what it means to worship. It is the same for us. We must come face to face with our own sinfulness in order to be set free for the purpose of worship. Sometimes we must face the pain to experience the victory.
