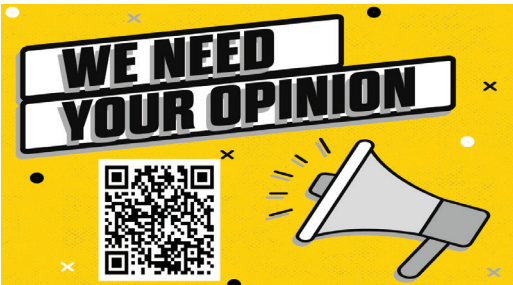
FAMILY PRAYER TIME

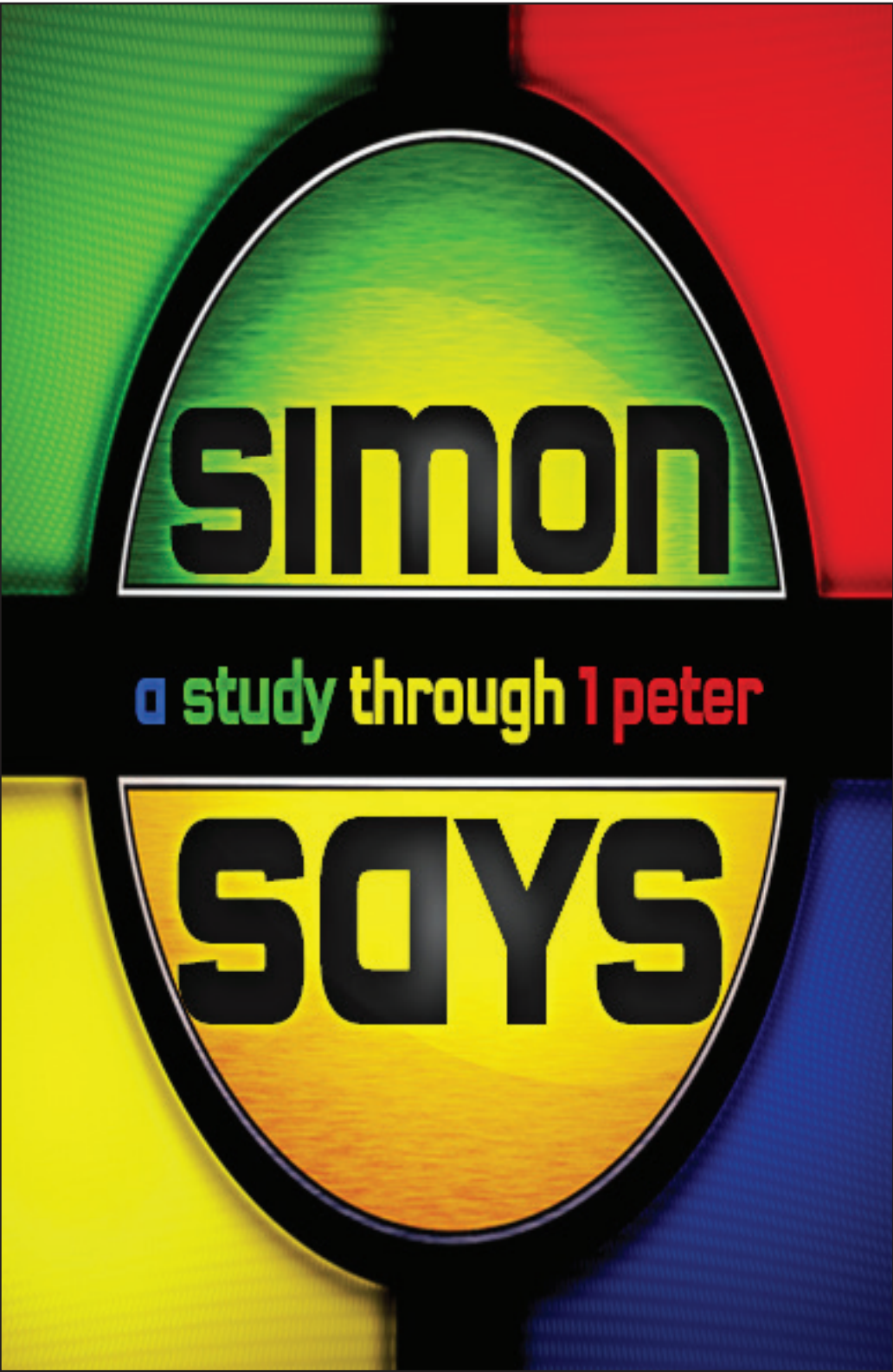
WOMEN'S RETREAT SURVEY

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

We live in a society that would love nothing more than to stifle your faith. It is almost as if they would say, “That’s fine if that is what you believe, just keep it to yourself.” And then somehow, out of fear of being viewed as fanatical, or out of step, or intolerant – we acquiesce. In the end, we are left with an anemic faith that even we cannot get excited about.

Today, Peter will challenge us to live passionate lives for Christ even when it is not popular. To be clear, he does not ask us to be careless, but he does ask us to be passionate. Toward our brothers and sisters in Christ, we are to be understanding and seek common ground. Toward outsiders, we are to stand strong, but we are not to return insult for insult or injury for injury. We are not called to live by the standards of this world, but by a higher standard.

The motivation for this life is rooted in who Jesus Christ is. We are told that He suffered in our place in order to offer forgiveness for our sin. That He, the righteous one, died for us, the unrighteous ones. His motivation – to open a way for us to get to God. As a result, we are to live lives passionately committed to Him. As we do, it will stir questions from others. We are called to be prepared to make a defense for the hope that we have.

Today, as we walk through our text, I pray that God will speak to your heart. If you are someone that has grown cold or complacent in your faith (it does happen), I hope you will be stirred once again. Our Lord was and is victorious. He passes that victory on to us. If we fully understand what such a victory means, we will never again approach our faith in an ordinary way.

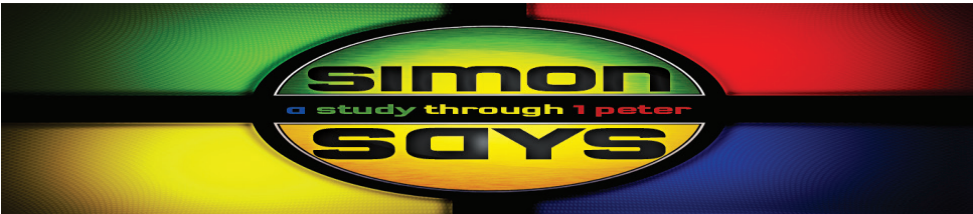

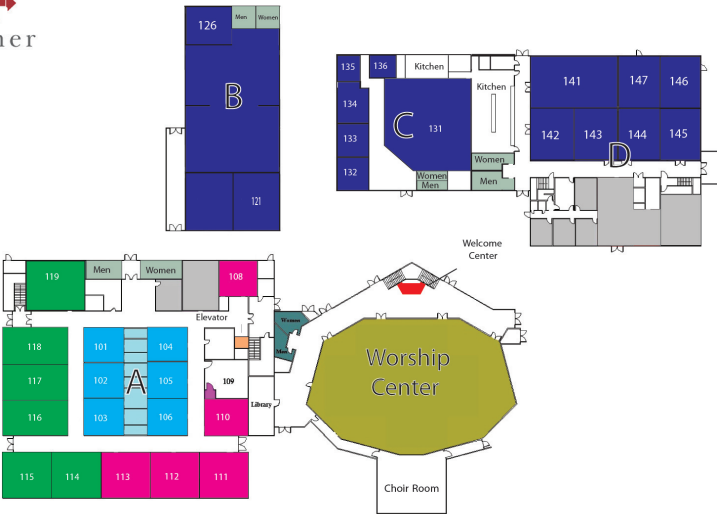
