OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD



Of course you can pack your own box and bring it by the church. We will deliver them with our boxes.


We are also accepting cash donations for shipping charges, boxes, and items to fill boxes. Mark your envelope "OCC".

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

One of the most frustrating things in life can be seeking the direction God would have you to go. I do not think God intends for this to be frustrating, but we complicate the process and become discouraged. Usually, we find ourselves at some crossroads, and instead of slowing down and trusting God, we muddy the waters. These times may come in the midst of a life decision, or as we seek where God would have us to serve, or maybe even when we are trying to decide how to handle some particular situation.

Satan would love to trip us up, take our joy, and leave us frustrated. However, we know that such confusion and frustration can never be from God, so why do we end up there? I think the short answer is that we look to all the wrong places when we find ourselves in seasons of decision and commitment. We try to approach things logically, or from a commonsense standpoint, or we seek the advice of people before we seek God.

While the use of common sense and the counsel of godly people are good things, they should not be our primary source or even our first stop. Before we try to use logic, or even speak to others, we should first approach the Lord and seek His guidance. Many times, what God is saying to us is to wait. Learning to wait and listen to Him is an invaluable skill. Our society says, "hurry up" while our God says, "wait."

Today we will talk about how one can seek the will of God and live according to His purposes. You will find that seeking God is a multifaceted process. Sometimes we have to wait. Sometimes we have to act. Sometimes we listen. Sometimes we move. On the one hand, there is no simple, singular way to get to the will of God. On the other hand, it is simple. We simply learn to listen and act as directed. I hope that you will find today helpful in your own journey.
