PRAIZ KIDZ/PRAIZ KIDZ JR.



Northside collected \$4,340 towards our goal of \$5,000 for the Mary Hill Davis offering for Texas Missions. Thank you for your help with this




NORTHSIDE WOMEN'S RETREAT

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

A few days ago, Toni and I were enjoying dinner at a local restaurant. I quickly came to understand why the menu choice that I made was called the "*Oh My God*" sushi roll. It was wonderful, but never ending. After briefly observing the beauty of the masterpiece that the Sushi Chef had created, I dug in. Sometime later, the waitress approached and asked "Is there anything else that I can get you?" To which, I responded, "I'm good!" But the fact was, I wasn't really...I had stuffed myself on this incredible sushi roll and egg drop soup and really needed a nap!

I'm not sure where the term "I'm good" came from, but it has become a regular part of my vocabulary. I hear other people using the term as well. There is even a song called "I'm Good". A favorite professor I had in seminary would often say, "Words are slippery...and often change. Thats why context is so important in understanding what is being said."

Insurgence Ministries here at Northside has been ministering to men that are returning home from incarceration. It's tough to transition back into a community when you've been locked up. The longer that you've been locked up, the harder it is. Upon exiting prison, without a plan and support system, it's easy to end up returning. What better support system could there be than a band of Christian brothers desiring to walk with you on the journey of becoming all that God intends you to be?

A few months ago, David Segura who serves as Northside's Facility Team Lead and I were ministering to a brother returning to Victoria County from prison. He had reached out to us because he had heard about me from visits with other inmates at the Victoria County Jail. Once he left Victoria County Jail and arrived at the prison where he would serve the remainder of his time, he wrote a letter to Insurgence Ministries at Northside. We communicated with him on a regular basis until his release. When he arrived back in Victoria County after serving his time he reached out to us. We helped him with necessities such as a hygiene packet, clothing, and groceries. He was happy to receive these items and had even lined up a job in construction. Things were looking up for him.


After getting this brother some of the material things he needed to start off on the right foot, David and I dropped him off at a home where he would be staying with relatives. Upon exiting the vehicle, David invited the brother to church and our Celebrate Recovery program where he could meet others and find encouragement. The brother listened to David, then responded, "Thanks for the help you have given me…but 'I'm Good.' If I need anything else, I will let you know…." And he walked off…

I was good... this brother was good... Are we all good?

It's all a matter of context...that is what we will be talking about today as we look at Mark 2:17-3:6.
