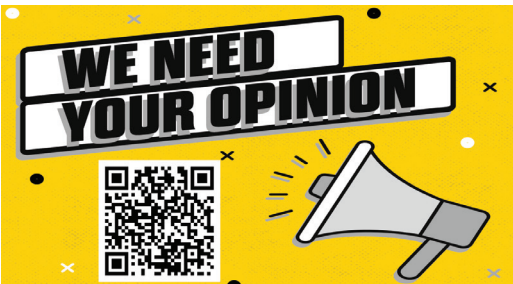
FALL FESTIVAL

WOMEN'S RETREAT SURVEY

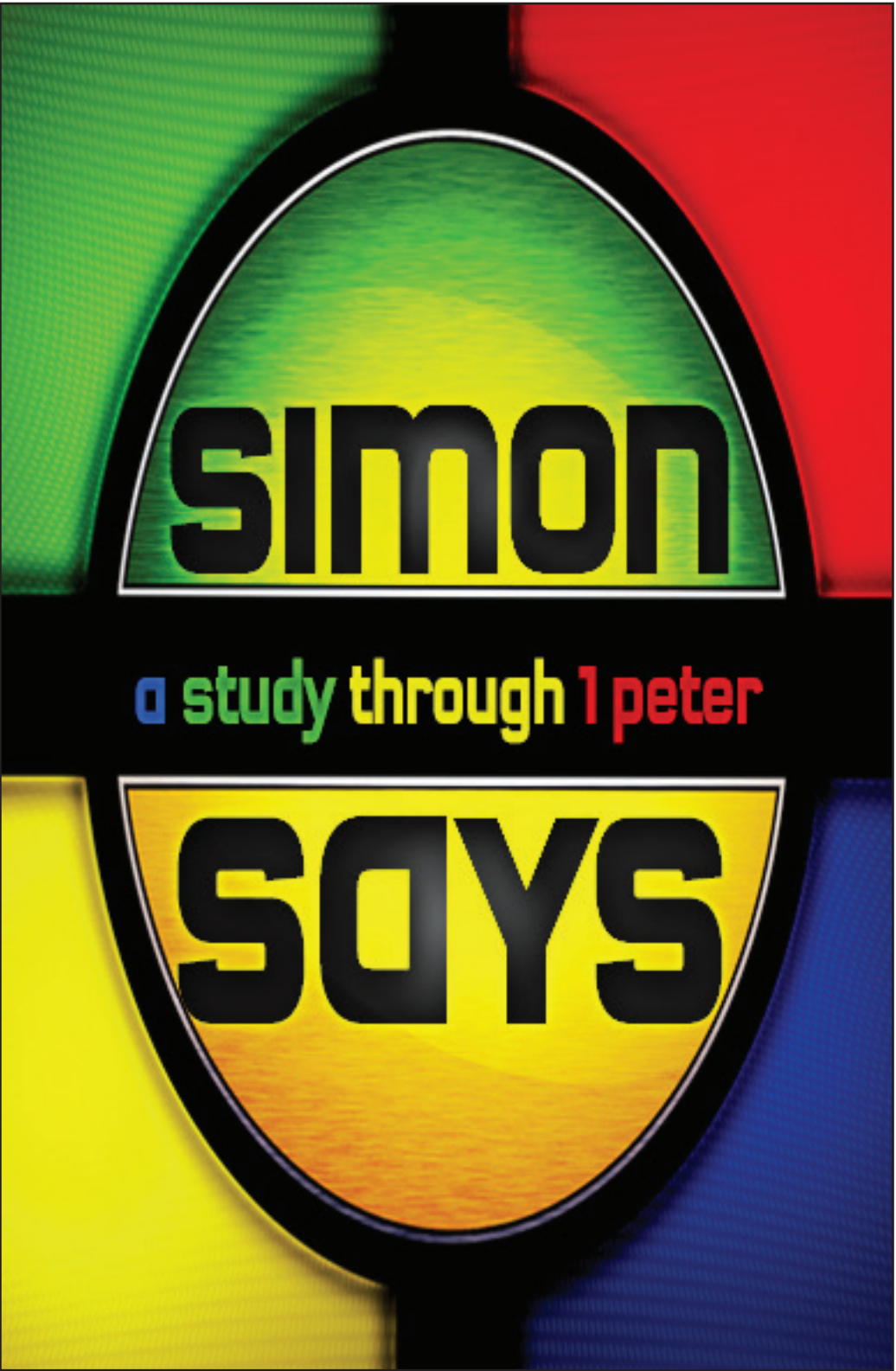

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY



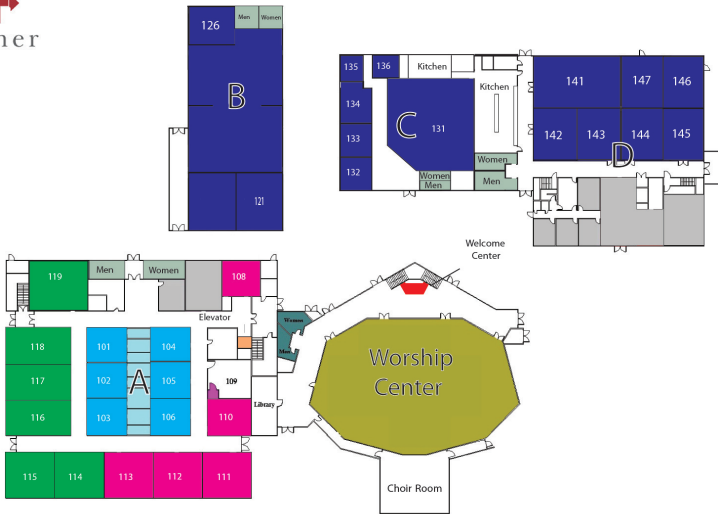
