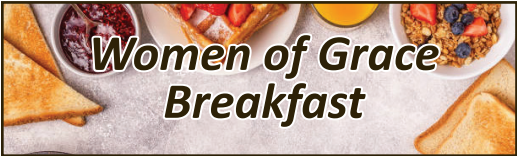


DATE NIGHT

Women of Grace (Widows) are having a breakfast at Northside on Friday, November 5, at 8:45. The catered breakfast is in room D-141.



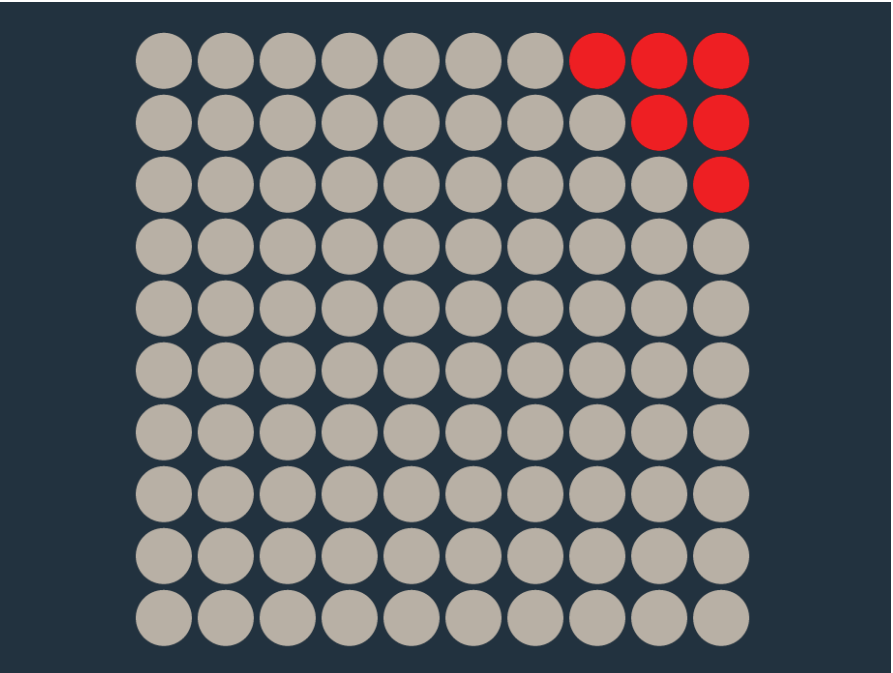
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

Of course you can pack your own box and bring it by the church. We will deliver them with our boxes.

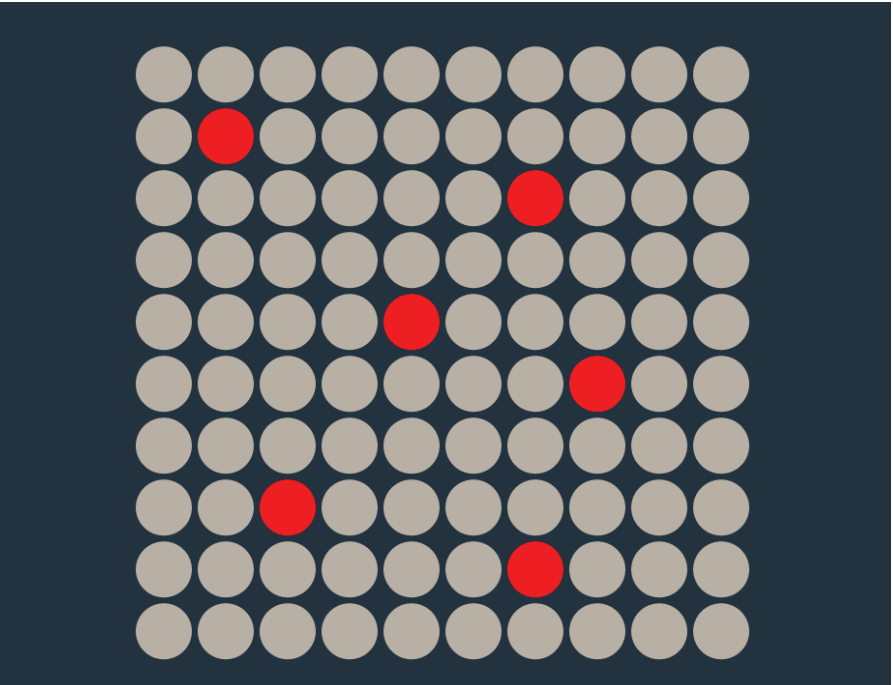
We are also accepting cash donations for shipping charges, boxes, and items to fill boxes. Mark your envelope "OCC".

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

One of the challenges we face as believers is to remember that we are always on mission – wherever we go. Once we are able to remember that we are on mission, we must begin to ask what that mission looks like. Part of our mission is defined by the “one another” passages that we find in the New Testament. In all, there are 59 “one another” passages that give us guidance as to how we are to behave toward one another.

Today, we will look at the importance of building one another up. At its surface, it seems pretty simple. However, when we get in the throws of life, sometimes it is hard to remember that this is part of my mission. Accomplishing this means that I am not so concerned with my own rights and privileges, but that I am more concerned with your wellbeing.

Once I begin to fully embrace this idea of building you up, as opposed to taking care of my own desires, I will begin to realize that it is going to call for some sacrifice. Sometimes it will mean I forego something that I have a right to. At other times, it might mean that I sacrifice my time. There will be still other times that I have to go out of my way to do something that I really do not feel like doing. In order to build you up, I must put you before myself.

Such sacrifice is not common in our culture. In fact, our culture would encourage you to do just the opposite. We hear phrases like – take care of yourself, look out for number one, and do what is best for you. These have become the cultural norm. But God is calling us to be countercultural and do that which is shocking and peculiar. We are called to do that which does not come naturally.

So, take time this week and consider who God has placed around you. Consider how you might put others first. Consider how you might “Build Up” those you come in contact with. At first, it will not come naturally, but in time it will become the new norm.
