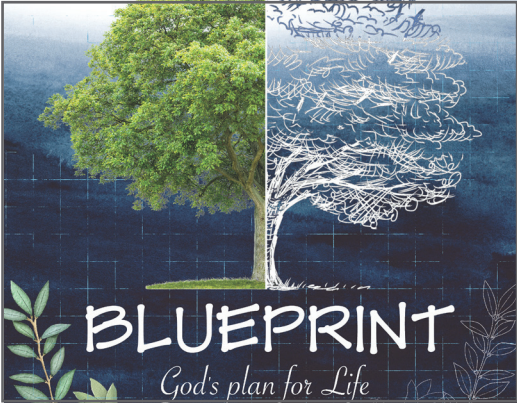
DATE NIGHTS

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

There is a lot of talk these days about setting and achieving goals. In fact, a quick internet search of, “How to set and achieve goals,” returned 783 million results. The simple fact is everyone wants a sense of success. No one really wants to just make it through life.

When it comes to being a follower of Jesus, all of our goals should be impacted by our relationship with Him. Each of our goals should reflect our desire to honor God and make Him known. Chief amongst our goals ought to be the desire to discover and obey His will for our lives.

I only wish it were that simple – discover and do. Unfortunately, in your pursuit to honor God, you can expect that there will be opposition. Sometimes that opposition will come from those who are closest to us. It will be our family and friends that will question our pursuits. If God calls you to take some giant leap of faith, those around you will quickly become uncomfortable and try to get you to temper your excitement.

This opposition can come in many forms. You might experience difficulties in general. The opposition may be spiritual or emotional. The opposition may come in the form of other people that do not like what you are doing. However it comes, rest assured, Satan will not watch you serve the Lord and ignore it.

In spite of the opposition that is sure to come, there is no higher goal that you could set for yourself than to know and do the will of God. Do not lose heart, press forward, and expect to see great things.
