OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

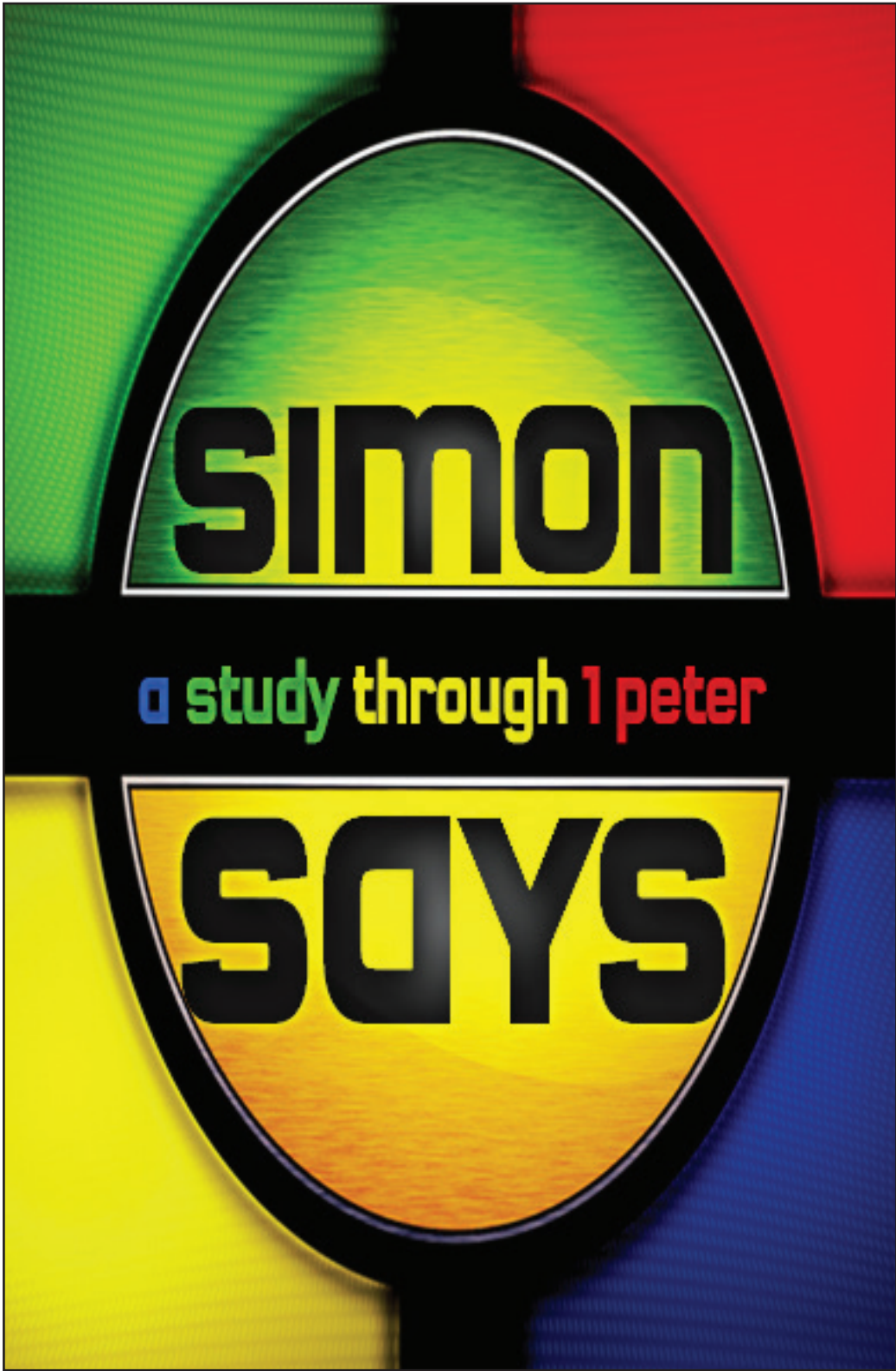

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

As we come this morning to the last chapter of this first letter from the Apostle Peter, let’s remember a few things. Peter wrote this to believers who were experiencing persecution in their area. He wrote to encourage them and to equip them for the difficult time they were living in. While widespread persecution didn’t begin until a few decades later than his writing, local persecution at the time could be quite severe.

“We are to continually be growing in the Word and living as solid as stones that are part of the spiritual house and holy priesthood.”

In this final chapter, Peter speaks to five things we can see as “charges” or directives, instructions about living for Jesus in the midst of an ungodly culture. Something at least in a small way, we can relate to. While we are not facing the persecution these believers were, we are experiencing a growing culture of animosity against Christianity. Keep in mind all that Peter has written as he closes this letter with these instructions. We have a Living Hope! We are to continually be growing in the Word and living as solid as stones that are part of the spiritual house and holy priesthood. We are to honor those in authority over us living with Christ as our example. Godly living is to be our goal always being ready to share with others why we believe and live the way we do. Even with temptation all around us (and within us) we are to live for the will of God. Don’t be surprised when trials come your way, this is a part of life.

So here we are, chapter five. Peter’s Charge to the Church. A charge issued to Pastors, to everyone, to individuals and finally in conclusion, the charge to stand firm in the faith!

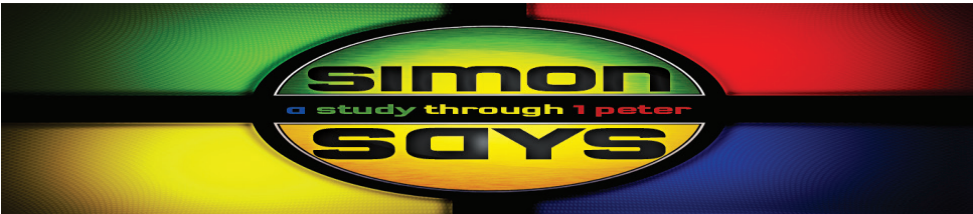

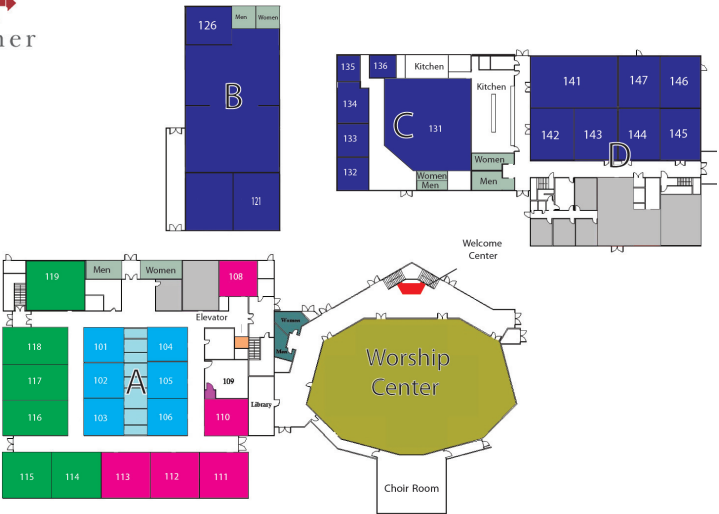
