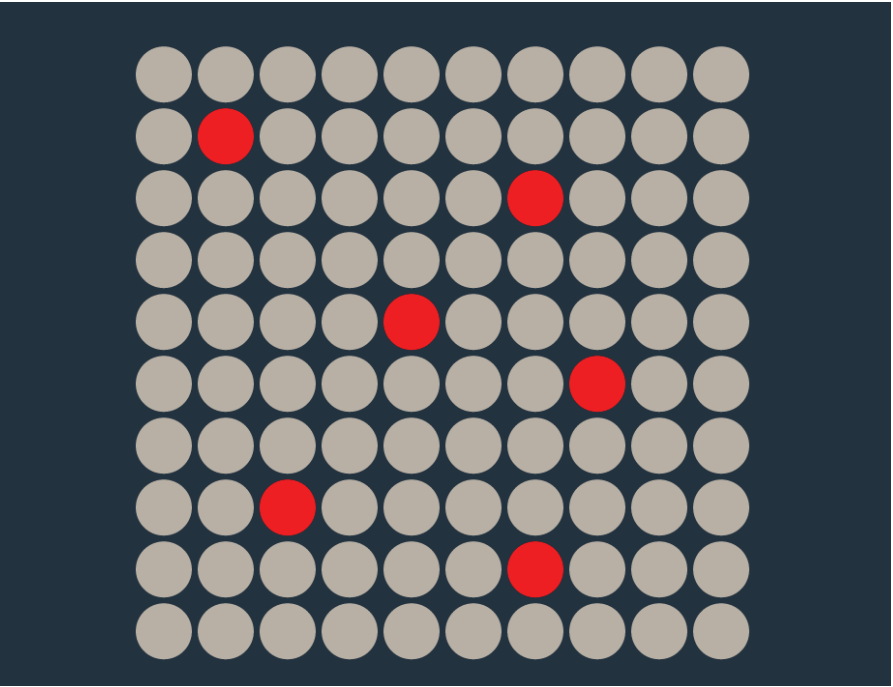
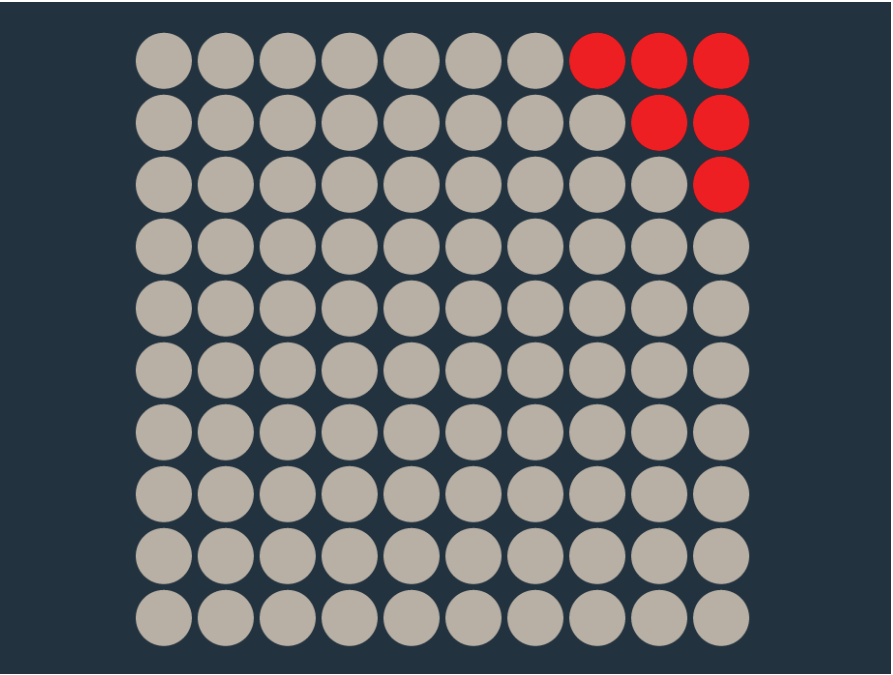
VETERAN'S DAY PARADE

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

There is within the human heart a desire to be in control. We see this desire expose itself from the very beginning of our story. It is the very thing that Satan used to tempt Adam and Eve. “*The Serpent said to the woman, ‘You will not surely die. For God knows that when you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil’*” (Genesis 3:3-4). Take note of the phrase that appears in the middle of that, “*you will be like God.*” Ultimately, that is our issue, we want to be like God, rule our own lives, and do as we please.

Sadly, our desire to be in control becomes our greatest hindrance. It hinders us from becoming what God desires us to be. It hinders us from experiencing joy. And, believe it or not, it hinders us from walking in freedom.

Today, we will look at a passage of scripture from Ephesians 5. We will see that the life Christ calls us to is not one in which we are in control, but one in which we walk in submission. We are to submit to God, but we are also to submit to one another.

If we are not careful, what we will fail to realize, is that submission actually comes from a place of strength and not a place of weakness. It takes a strong person to say, Lord, I will surrender to your will. It takes a strong person to say, I will surrender to the leadership of the Holy Spirit. It takes a strong person to walk in an attitude of thanksgiving and praise, even when things are not going well. And it certainly takes a strong person to say, I will submit to and serve others out of reverence for Jesus Christ.

The kind of strength that we see here is exactly the kind of strength to which God is calling us. Surrender is not typically thought of as a means to greater strength, but in the ways of God it is the exact means. So, heed the call of God today, surrender to His will, to the leadership of the Holy Spirit, and to one another.

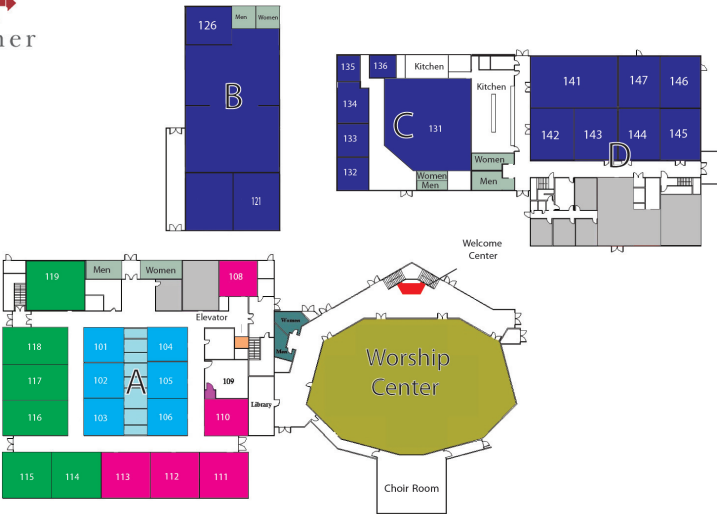
