THE CHRISTMAS CODE



HYPE


The next HYPE is December 3. Kids in 3rd through 5th grade are invited to attend for lots of fun.

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY


Paul gives us a command in Colossians 3:13 to, "bear with one another." Take just a moment and consider that phrase. Not only do we need to consider that phrase, but we need to consider all that it implies. You do not have to bear with people who are easy to get along with. Typically, we do not have to bear with people who are like us. They may frustrate us, but we understand them.

Paul's call to bear with one another is telling us that there are going to be people in the church that are difficult to deal with. They will have thoughts, ideas, and behaviors that are different than our own. They will act in ways we do not understand. Our natural inclination would be to stay away from them and find friends who are more like us. However, Paul says that we are instead to learn what it means to bear with one another.


The church may be one of the most peculiar institutions that has ever been developed. Only in the church do you bring people from different backgrounds, races, socio-economic levels, education backgrounds, and different career paths together in one place. We bring this diversity of people and ideas together and then ask them to unify behind a singular vision of making disciples for Jesus Christ. Not only do we ask them to agree on vision, but we also ask them to agree on strategy. In all honesty, I really do not think it would work anywhere else other than the church.

The good news is, that Paul does not just tell us what to do, he tells us how to do it. We are commanded to embrace the traits that the Holy Spirit will produce in our lives. We are to be a people who are compassionate, kind, humble, meek, and patient. We are to, above all, be a people of love (see Colossians 3:12, 14). As we embrace the characteristics that the Spirit will produce in our lives, we are empowered to bear with one another.
