Our school now has drop-in care available. This service is for kids 2 - 5 years old. Call the school at 578-5601 if you have any questions.


VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

BEHOLD THE LAMB OF GOD



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

There are not many certainties in life, but one thing that is sure is that storms in life will come. For each of these storms, we must decide how we will respond. Will we respond with fear and anxiety, or will we respond with faith and trust?

Today, we will see a story about Jesus and His disciples. After a long day of teaching, Jesus and His disciples set out to cross the Sea of Galilee. Jesus, exhausted from a long day of ministry, had fallen asleep on the boat. During their journey, a storm arose. This was no small storm. In fact, scripture says it was a "great windstorm." The Greek word is actually the same word as "hurricane." So, we get the sense that things were bad.

As the storm raged, and the boat began to take on water, the disciples became more and more fearful. They could not understand how Jesus was fast asleep in the stern of the boat. Finally, they awaken Jesus and ask Him if He even cares that they are about to perish. Jesus gets up, speaks to the storm, and everything stops. The bible tells us that there was a "great calm."

While the storm we face may not be those that the sailors faced, we certainly have our own kind of storm. The question for us is the same that it was for the disciples in the boat that day – will we live in faith, or will we live in fear? The truth is that God invites us to a place of peace. He wants us to trust that He can handle the storms we face. He wants us to walk in perfect peace.

Today, if you are facing storms, I pray that the sermon will speak to you. I pray the hope and peace that you need in this passage of scripture. We must remind ourselves that God is sovereign over illness, sovereign over life, and He is sovereign over the storms we face. It is in this truth that we find hope.


