I want to do a little something different with my article this week. Instead of sharing some of my thoughts, I want to issue you a challenge. In my mind, this will be a great family activity. However, if your kids have already left home, or you find yourself otherwise alone, I think this can be a great devotional activity.

So here is the challenge...

In today's passage, we see that Mary sang a song in response to all that was going on. This song expressed her feelings and views as they related to God. I would like for you to write your own song of praise, using Mary's song as somewhat of a model. You will notice that Mary's song focuses in on different attributes of God: His power, His holiness, His mercy, and His sovereignty. You can use these attributes for your song, or maybe you can focus in on other attributes that have been meaningful to you.

Once you have a rough outline of the things you would focus on, look for words that would actually give your song rhyme and meter. You will be surprised how closely thinking about these things will enhance your understanding of who God is and even what He means to you. If you want bonus points (just kidding, you won't be turning these in), pick a song we know and set your worship song to its melody.

We often complain about new songs. We say that they are shallow, or repeat their words too many times, or that they are unfamiliar. However, the Bible often speaks of "a new song." A new song is reflective of the fact that God is still moving in new and fresh ways. I do not think our real complaint is that songs are new, but that they lack meaning and weight. So, strive to give your song deep meaning and weight.

If you would like to share your song with me or Pastor Stephen, we would be honored to see them.
