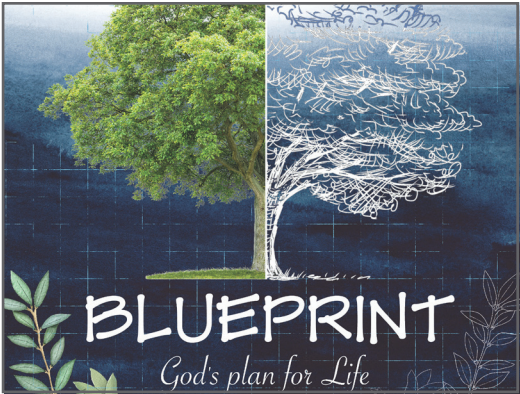


THANKSGIVING SCHEDULE

THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY

The destructive force of sin in an individual’s life cannot be overstated. Usually our journey into sin is not a sudden decision to turn our back on Christ. Instead, it is a series of small, sometimes inconsequential, compromises. But overtime, the fade becomes greater and greater. The day will come that we realize we have traveled farther than we ever intended to and stayed much longer than we desired. We look around and our life is a wreck, and we wonder how it happened.

While the consequences of sin may not be immediate, they are nonetheless real. The impact on our life, and those around us, is great. The harm that is done is usually more severe than we ever considered. While the road into sin seemed simple enough, the road out can be difficult. So what are we to do if we find ourselves in this place?

In our text today, we will meet a man whose life had been utterly destroyed by sin. His sin has isolated him, dominated him, and controlled him. Once you meet him, it will be hard to imagine anyone’s life being more impacted by sin than his. However, he was not a lost cause. There was hope. The end of his story was not written. He was about to come to a turning point.

Seemingly by chance, though we know better, this man had a face to face encounter with Jesus Christ. This encounter was life changing. Jesus set him free from his sin and the consequences of his sin. In fact, the change in his life was so great that the people who knew him best could not believe it. He went from a sinful wreck to someone who was touched and commissioned by grace. He went from one controlled by sin and the forces of evil to one under the control of the Holy Spirit. It truly was nothing short of a miracle.

This is more than a story recorded in the Bible. This story stands as a testimony of the change that can happen in the worst of sinners’ lives.

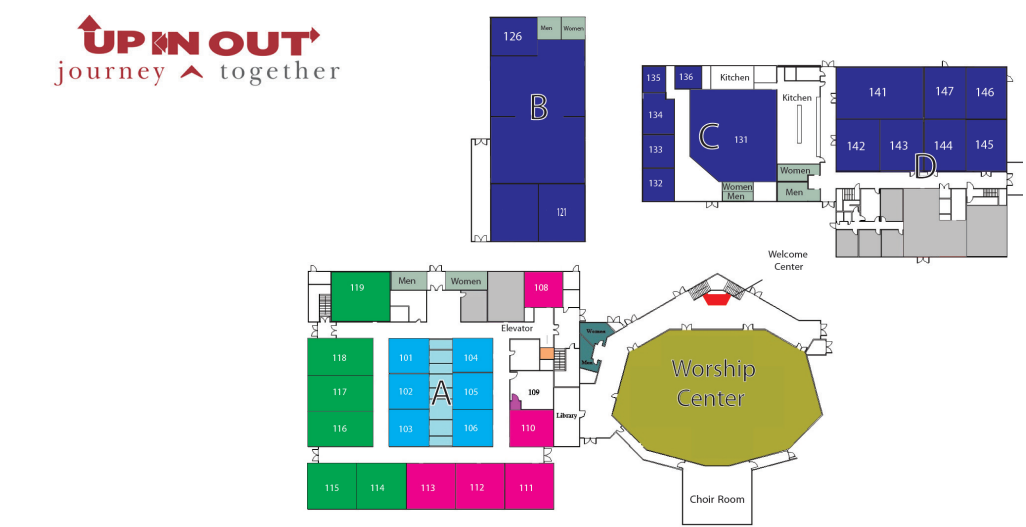
