UPWARD SOCCER REGISTRATION OPEN

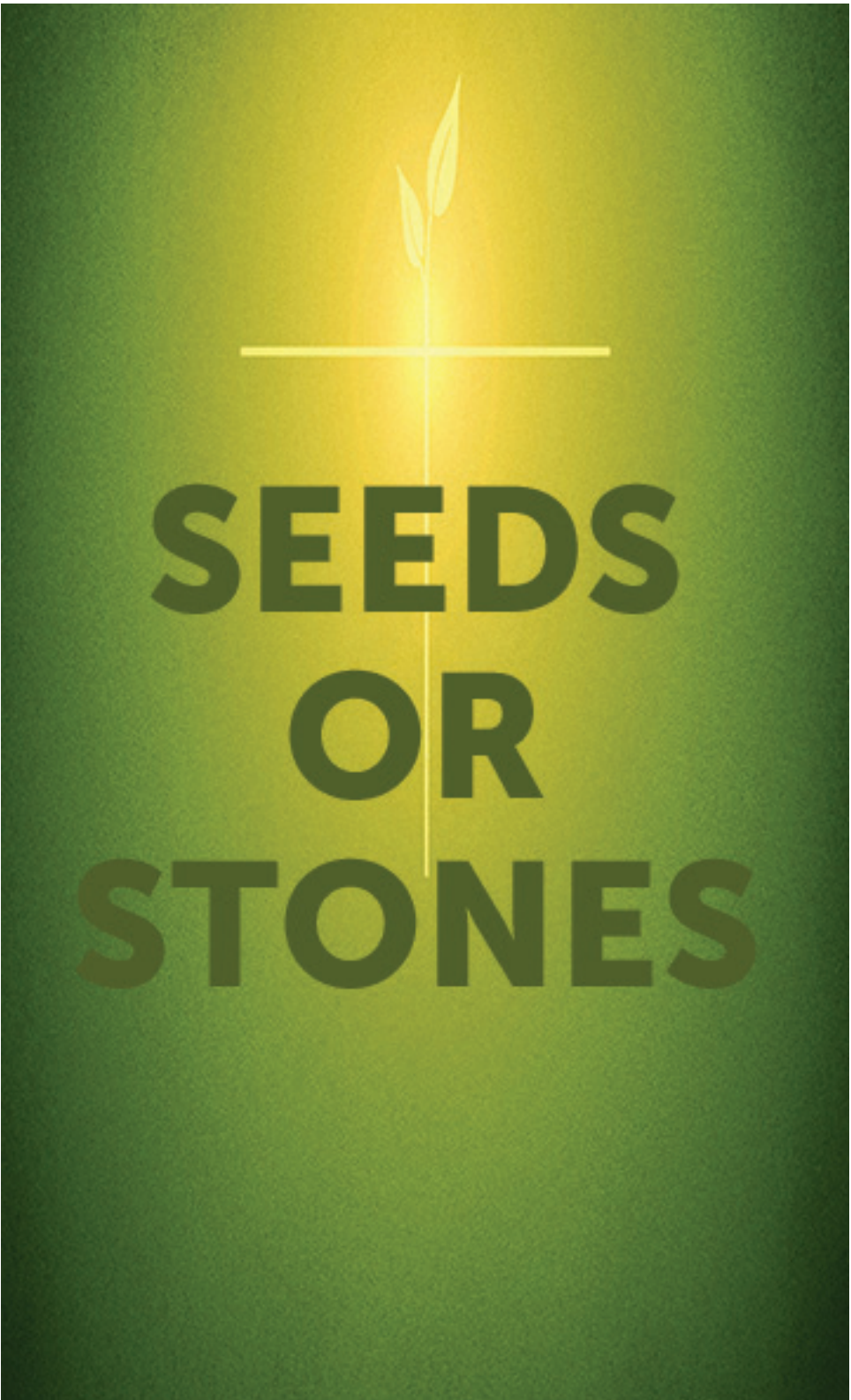
