Register on the events page of our website now for RAD Weekend, January 28-30, 2022. Cost is \$35. RAD is for students in the 6th - 12th grade.



THOUGHTS ON THE JOURNEY


John 3:16 is a familiar passage to church goer and non-church goer alike. If you have watched a football game on television, you have likely seen someone in the crowd holding up a sign with this verse written on it. Players will, from time to time, write this verse on their person in one way or another. It is probably the most quoted verse out of the bible, maybe with the exception of, "Jesus wept." However, have we ever stopped and asked ourselves why this verse has gained such traction?

The verse reads as follows, "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." When we dissect this verse, we get a clue as to why it is so popular. First it speaks of God's love for the world. This is not a casual love, but a love that has spurred to action. Specifically, that action was to give. And what did God give, His only Son. Rarely do we see love so profound that it would lead to sacrifice. Even rarer is a love that leads to sacrifice of this magnitude. God gave His son for you and me.


However, the beauty of this verse does not stop there. We are told that, "whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life." This love is not for the elite alone. This is not a love that is only available to the few. It is not a love that is presented to those who have their lives together. It is, indeed, a love for all people. Regardless of where you are coming from and what you have done, if you will put your belief in Him, you will have eternal life.

God invites all people, from all places, to trust in Him. Make no mistake about it, you may come from where you are, but He will not leave you where you are. God calls us to Himself and transforms us into the likeness of His image. This is the very reality that today's text (Luke 2:8-13) will make clear. God sends his angels to the lowliest of the low and invites them to be a part of the birth of a king. Not just a king, but THE KING. The invitation to be a part of what God is doing is not for the shepherds alone, but is for us as well.
