
## Serving our Community

Each time we take the kids to school, we drive by the Whitefish Football Stadium. It is the center of the community during the Fall each year - the picture of small town every Friday night as the community shows up decked out in Bulldog green and gold to cheer on the football team. There are kids running everywhere, a middle school section monitored by a jovial principal, and seats close to the action on the field.

Each time Curt drove past the football stadium he noticed how badly it needed to be repainted. Early in the summer he reached out to the athletic director and offered to gather people to paint it. A week before school started, Curt received a message that said we could paint the stadium. The catch was that we only had a week to do it before the first home game and a booster event in the middle of the week that required the stands to be completely dry. Upon getting the go-ahead, Curt immediately sent a text to a group of men he's been meeting with all year for bible study. Within a minute, he received a response that said, call me. Curt called the man back only to hear, "Did you know that I am the head of the Booster Club and we have been trying for years to get permission to paint the stadium? How in the world did you get a yes?" Curt's response was simple; God did it. He opened the doors. Just like He has been doing time and time again.

Volunteers from all areas of Whitefish came around to help paint the stadium and it was done in record time. Not without a lot of hard work (and a lot of tedious sanding) but it got done. It not only became a community-wide effort but it established goodwill for Goodwater. Yet another reminder that when the Lord opens doors, we want to be ready and available to say YES!!















#### **Ministry Partners**

Through the generosity of Easthaven Baptist Church (our partner church here in the Flathead Valley) and other partners, we were able to purchase a trailer to house all of our equipment. We are praying for joyful hearted people eager to jump in and serve with us - even in the setting up and tearing down each week!

In early September, we were able to return to FBG for the first time and it was a joy to return and see the faces of so many people who have faithfully prayed for our family and invested in the work of Goodwater.

We were also able to spend some incredible time with our partners from the CrossCreek Network which is a church-planting initiative designed to plant disciple-making churches locally, nationally, and globally. We spent three days in training with them in Colleyville, Texas. We had incredible conversations during our time together, soaking up the wisdom and counsel of experienced church planters who spent years ministering in the Pacific Northwest and beyond. Their open-handed generosity in time, wisdom, and resources was incredible! It is a joy to partner in this gospel work with them!
