Preschool Class Descriptions

In all of our classes, we focus on development of Social-Emotional Skills, Fine Motor Skills, Handedness (left or right), Writing Readiness, Crayon/Pencil Grip, and a love of Jesus and who God created us to be. We strike a balance between free play, table time, play-based learning, and independent exploration. Our teachers are well-equipped to challenge students and encourage them to learn new skills and ideas every day.

The school is open to all children regardless of race, creed, color or national origin. However, the school is not equipped to handle children with excessive emotional, visual, speech, hearing or other severe handicaps. Children with particular needs can be assessed to determine that: 1) The child will benefit from our program. 2) The staff is able to meet the individual needs of the child. 3) There will be no adverse effect on the other children through direct behavior. 4) The child does not require extra staff assistance. (Taking time away from other students.)

Students must be completely potty trained. This means that your child can take care of all aspects of toileting without using a pull-up. This includes recognizing the urge to go, undressing, dressing, cleaning, and hand washing.

2 Day Preschool

Tuesday & Thursday, 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

This class is created especially for children with no preschool experience, age 3 and up. Our teachers give students a great introduction to school routines and beginning preschool academics: identifying uppercase letters, counting from 0-10, colors, shapes, and vocabulary building. We focus on learning through sharing, play, singing, imitation, pre-writing, coloring, tracing, and socialization. Students will participate in Chapel and Music once a week.

3 Day Preschool

Monday, Wednesday, Friday, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

This class is designed for children age 3 or 4 who are ready to learn, with or without previous preschool experience. This class will focus on helping children prepare for Kindergarten or our Pre-Kindergarten class. Our skilled teachers build preschool knowledge: identifying and writing uppercase letters and numbers 0-20, knowing colors and shapes, identifying patterns, learning about science/social studies topics, and vocabulary building. Students participate in Chapel, Music, and PE once a week.

4 Day Pre-Kindergarten

Monday - Thursday, 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

This class is designed for children who have had previous preschool experience and intend to register for Kindergarten the next fall. Students in this class participate in Chapel, Music, and PE throughout the week. Curriculum focuses on writing upper and lowercase letters, writing numbers and counting from 0-20, practicing letter sounds and beginning sight words, identifying rhyming words, recognizing patterns, and learning a variety of science/social studies topics.

5 Day Pre-Kindergarten (4 Day with Friday Fun Day!)

Monday - Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Tuition: \$310/month All the benefits of our 4 Day PreK program PLUS a fun-filled enrichment Friday! Science, baking, art, field trips, special guests, special holiday celebrations, sensory bins, and more! You never know what's in store on this amazing day.

Tuition Discounts and Financial Aid Options

Sibling Discount: For more than one child enrolled, a 10% discount will be given off the lowest paid tuition.

Pay-in-Full Discount: Pay in full by September 9, 2022 and receive a 3% discount on tuition (does not apply to Kids Club or registration fees). PIF Amount: 5 Day = \$2,7004 Day = \$22703 Day = \$1,8302 Day = \$1,390

Financial Aid: Scholarships are available to cover part of tuition. Volunteer hours will be required. Number of hours is based on the class your child is enrolled in.
