1 John 3.16-18 By this we know love, that He laid down His life for us, and we ought to lay down our lives for the brothers. Little children, let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth.

Isaiah 55.3 Incline your ear, and come to me; hear, that your soul may live; and I will make with you an everlasting covenant, my steadfast, sure love for David.

At that moment she was in the hospital with her husband. We prayed, not knowing the fullness of the situation. It was a quick call, a simple prayer. God knew the timing, He knew the peace He would bring to this person in this moment, and He brought discernment to the medical team. I offer this example as encouragement as we strive to love in action, connecting to God.

Is the Lord bringing someone to your mind that you want to call or send a text? Perhaps someone He wants to see you reconcile with, or someone in your life that needs something special done for them – a meal or a driveway shoveled. Is God asking you to pray daily for a friend, a group of people or a country in severe trauma? Prayer matters, and how grateful I am, our church family is, for your prayers. Thank you for lifting up our weekly prayer letter requests. Thank you for taking time to talk with God. And thank you for listening to our Father in Heaven with the intent of obeying. He is love.
