


Connect with Grace


New to QR Codes? Give it a try!

Portraits of Ambassadors: Jonah Goes Down

Scriptures: Matthew 9:13, Jonah 1:1-16

Study Questions

1. What is the genre of Jonah and what are the signs from how it is written that indicate its genre?
2. Jonah rebels against God... why do you think he's running away?
3. Ancient people believed that religion was politics with the powers of the world, and so the whole social body was implicated if things were going bad. Do you think God operates in this way? (Hint: see Jeremiah 31:29-30 or Ezekiel 18:2-4)
4. How do the Gentiles get it more right than Jonah? How are they still getting it wrong?

Implications: So What?

5. The sailors offer sacrifice to Yahweh because they fear him... Jesus says that God doesn't want sacrifice but mercy... Do you think Jonah's problem is that he disobeyed a command, or that he lacked the merciful heart of God?

Applications: Now What?

6. Where is your heart? Do you think God is after your obedience for its own sake? Or is God interested in forming his own heart in you?

Prayer

Pray that God would create in you (and in all of us) a clean heart, a heart that is after his own, that has mercy on sinners (like we are too!). Let's pray also that we can be a community that puts the mercy of God on bright display for all Yakima to see.
