Portraits of Ambassadors: Jonah Disciplined

Scriptures: Luke 8:22-25, Jonah 1:17-2:10

Outline

Study Questions

1. The sea and its megafauna were to the Jewish mind, symbols of chaos, of the uncontrollable, the ultra-wild. Yet though other people groups saw these as "monsters" of "chaos" that the gods of civilization have to wage war against. But in the Bible they are God's creatures. How have you understood God's sovereignty in relation to creation?
2. Jonah was disciplined for his disobedience. What's the difference between punishment and discipline?
3. The shape of Jonah's repentance is, like the speeches of many in the Bible, a person speaking for a whole people. What do you make of the collectivity that the Bible presents in a world focused so much on individuals? How do individual behaviors fit into a larger collectivity?

Implications: So What?

4. The story of Jonah like that of the whole Old Testament wrestles with God in terms of the justifiability of their suffering. How could we distinguish between what God is inflicting or even using as discipline for growth, and what is the power of evil and darkness that inflicts suffering for its benefit?

Applications: Now What?

5. Where do you need to repent and grow in maturity? Where do you need to recognize that you are suffering injustice and refuse to bear responsibility for the evil of others?
6. And how does this question apply also to our church community? What have we done that needs repentance? What injustices have been suffered?

Prayer

Let us pray that God would help us discern and give us counsel from others to discern where we are responsible for needing to grow and change, and where we reject the influence of evil. We can also pray that God would transform us, like Jonah (and Israel) to be a people who can shoulder the burden of being lights in the midst of darkness.
