


New to QR Codes? Give it a try!

Portraits of Ambassadors: Jonah Rises and Goes

Scriptures: Matthew 12:38-42, 2 Peter 3:8-10, Jonah 3

Study Questions

1. What's the link between 2 Peter 3 and Jonah 3? What do these passages read together show about the heart of God?
2. What is the difference between Jonah's repentance in chapter 2 and that of the people of Nineveh?
3. What's the importance of all the sackcloth, ashes, and fasting? What does it show?

Implications: So What?

4. There are many thoughts about how God is active in the world on a spectrum from pulling all the strings, to working behind the scenes, to totally uninvolved. What picture of God's work in the world do we get from the book of Jonah?

Applications: Now What?

5. The people of Nineveh didn't know or obey God's law, yet they repented. Are there people in your life like this?
6. Patience is not permission. How does the idea of God being patient with evil make you feel?

Prayer

The story of Jonah is complex and reaches down to the heart of the "problem of evil" and the particular biblical answer to it in the space of God's patience to answer the call to be ambassadors of God. We can be honest with God in the challenges we face, the experience of evil, the feeling that God is doing nothing, that the evildoers win, etc. God isn't afraid of our hard feelings. We can also pray for those who persecute, as Jesus commands. We can pray for people like those of Nineveh, that they would truly repent.
